5	(a) There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State, the
6	Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a trust fund to
7	be known as the "Arkansas Interoperable Communications Trust Fund".
8	(b) The fund shall consist of funds received by the Arkansas
9	Interoperable Communications Executive Council, fees and revenues collected
10	under § 12-75-101 et seq., and any other moneys as may be provided by law.
11	(c) The fund shall be used for the operation, maintenance, and
12	improvement of the statewide interoperable communications system.
