21	WHEREAS, the Drafters of our United States Constitution empowered State
22	Legislatures to be guardians of liberty against future abuses of power by the
23	federal government; and

25	WHEREAS, the federal government has created a crushing national debt
26	through improper and imprudent spending; and

28	WHEREAS, the federal government has invaded the legitimate roles of the
29	states through the manipulative process of federal mandates, most of which
30	are unfunded; and

32	WHEREAS, the federal government has ceased to function under a proper
33	interpretation of the Constitution of the United States; and

35	WHEREAS, it is the solemn duty of the states to protect the liberty of
36	our people — particularly for the generations to come — by proposing

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL
7 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL
8 MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

10 THAT the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas hereby applies to 11 Congress, under the provisions of Article V of the Constitution of the United 12 States, for the calling of a convention of the states limited to proposing 13 amendments to the Constitution of the United States that impose fiscal 14 restraints on the federal government, limit the power and jurisdiction of the 15 federal government, and limit the terms of office for its officials and for 16 members of Congress.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives is hereby directed to transmit copies of this application to the President of the United States Senate, the Secretary of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, the Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, each member of the Arkansas congressional delegation, and the presiding officers of each of the legislative houses in the several states, requesting their cooperation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this application constitutes a continuing application in accordance with Article V of the Constitution of the United States until the legislatures of at least two-thirds (2/3) of the several states have made applications on the same subject.
