1	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL
2	MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:
3	
4	THAT the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
5	the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
6	for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives
7	and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
8	adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of
9	the State of Arkansas, to wit:
10	
11	SECTION 1. Article 3 of the Arkansas Constitution is amended to add an
12	additional section to read as follows:
13	§ 13. Presentation of identification when casting a ballot.
14	(a) A voter voting in person either early or at the polls on election
15	day shall present valid government-issued photographic identification before
16	receiving a ballot.
17	(b) A voter voting by absentee ballot shall submit with his or her
18	absentee ballot proof of identity.
19	(c)(l)(A) A voter unable to present government-issued photographic
20	identification under subsection (a) of this section shall be permitted to
21	vote a provisional ballot.
22	(B) A provisional ballot cast under subdivision (c)(l) of
23	this section shall be counted only if the voter subsequently certifies the
24	provisional ballot in the manner provided by law.
25	(2) An absentee ballot submitted without proof of identity under
26	subsection (b) of this section shall be counted only if the voter
27	subsequently certifies the absentee ballot in the manner provided by law.
28	(d)(1) The General Assembly shall enact laws necessary to implement
29	this section, including without limitation laws:
30	(A) Establishing the types of government-issued
31	photographic identification that a voter may present to receive a ballot;
32	(B) Identifying the items that may be submitted with an
33	absentee ballot to fulfill the proof of identity requirement; and
34	(C) Establishing the process for:
35	(i) A voter who votes a provisional ballot due to
36	his or her inability to present government-issued photographic identification

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1	to certify his or her provisional ballot so that it may be counted; and
2	(ii) A voter voting by absentee ballot who fails to
3	submit proof of identity with his or her absentee ballot to certify his or
4	her ballot so that it may be counted.
5	(2) The General Assembly may provide by law for exceptions to
6	the requirements of subsections (a) and (b) of this section, including
7	without limitation establishing requirements for a person registering to vote
8	by mail who has not previously voted in a federal election in this state.
9	(e)(l) The State of Arkansas shall issue photographic identification
10	at no charge to an eligible voter who does not have a form of identification
11	meeting the requirements of the laws enacted by the General Assembly under
12	this section.
13	(2) A copy of photographic identification issued under
14	subdivision (e)(l) of this section shall qualify as proof of identity when
15	submitted with an absentee ballot.
16	(f) A voter meeting the requirements of this section shall also comply
17	with all additional laws regulating elections necessary for his or her vote
18	to be counted.
19	
20	SECTION 2. BALLOT TITLE AND POPULAR NAME. When this proposed
21	amendment is submitted to the electors of this state on the general election
22	<u>ballot:</u>
23	(1) The title of this Joint Resolution shall be the ballot
24	title; and
25	(2) The popular name shall be "An Amendment to the Arkansas
26	Constitution Requiring a Voter to Present Certain Identification When Casting
27	a Ballot and Requiring the State of Arkansas To Issue Photographic
28	Identification at No Charge to an Eligible Voter Who Does Not Have a Form of
29	Identification Meeting the Requirements of the Amendment."
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31	SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This amendment is effective on July 1,
