8 AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION CONCERNING
9 THE PROVISION OF AN ADEQUATE EDUCATION TO ARKANSAS
10 STUDENTS; AND PROVIDING THAT STATE FUNDS EXPENDED IN
11 SUPPORT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION SHALL NOT EXCEED A
12 CERTAIN PERCENTAGE OF OVERALL STATE EXPENDITURES.

16 A CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT CONCERNING THE
17 PROVISION OF AN ADEQUATE EDUCATION TO
18 ARKANSAS STUDENTS.

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETIETH GENERAL
22 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL
23 MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

25 That the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
26 the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
27 for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives
28 and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
29 adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of
30 the State of Arkansas, to wit:

32 SECTION 1. The purpose of this resolution is to propose an amendment
33 to the Arkansas Constitution concerning the provision of an adequate
34 education to Arkansas students by providing that state funds expended in
35 support of public education shall not exceed a certain percentage of overall
36 state expenditures.
