28	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETIETH GENERAL
29	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL
30	MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:
31	
32	That the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
33	the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
34	for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives
35	and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
36	adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of

3 SECTION 1. Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 6, § 3, is amended to read 4 as follows:

5

§ 3. Election of Governor and Lieutenant Governor.

6 (a) The Governor and Lieutenant Governor shall be elected at the times 7 and places of choosing members of the Assembly. A candidate for Lieutenant 8 Governor shall run jointly with a candidate for Governor, and his or her name 9 shall appear jointly on the ballot with the candidate for Governor. The 10 Governor and Lieutenant Governor shall be chosen jointly by the casting of a single vote applicable to both offices. A candidate for Governor shall 11 12 select the candidate for Lieutenant Governor with whom he or she shall run 13 jointly. A person shall not file as a candidate for Lieutenant Governor. A 14 candidate for Governor seeking the nomination of a political party shall 15 select the candidate for Lieutenant Governor with whom he or she shall run 16 jointly no later than sixty (60) days before the preferential primary 17 election. The persons respectively jointly having the highest number of 18 votes for Governor and Lieutenant Governor shall be elected as Governor and 19 Lieutenant Governor, respectively, but in case two or more shall more than 20 two (2) joint candidates have an equal and the highest number of votes for 21 Governor, or for and Lieutenant Governor respectively, the two houses of the 22 Legislature at its next annual session shall forthwith, by joint ballot, 23 choose one of among the said persons joint candidates so having an equal and 24 the highest number of votes for Governor or and Lieutenant Governor for the 25 office of Governor and Lieutenant Governor, respectively.

(b) The General Assembly may enact laws necessary to implement this
section, including without limitation laws necessary to provide that the
Lieutenant Governor shall run jointly with a candidate for Governor.

30 SECTION 2. Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 6, § 4 is amended to read 31 as follows:

§ 4. Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor.

In case of the impeachment of the Governor, or his <u>or her</u> removal from office, death, inability to discharge the powers and duties of the said office, <u>or</u> resignation or absence from the State, the powers and duties of the office, shall devolve upon the Lieutenant Governor for the residue of the

1 term, or until the disability shall cease. But when When the Governor shall, 2 with the consent of the Legislature, be out of the State, in time of war, at 3 the head of a military force thereof, he or she shall continue commander-in-4 chief of all the military force of the State. 5 6 SECTION 3. Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 6, is amended to add an 7 additional section to read as follows: 8 § 7. Additional duties and responsibilities of Lieutenant Governor. 9 (a) The Governor may assign duties and responsibilities to the 10 Lieutenant Governor as he or she deems necessary. 11 (b) The General Assembly may provide by law for additional duties and 12 responsibilities of the Lieutenant Governor. 13 14 SECTION 4. Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 29, Section 1, is amended 15 to read as follows: 16 § 1. Elective offices - Exceptions. 17 Vacancies in the office of United States Senator, and in all elective 18 state, district, circuit, county, and township offices except those of 19 Lieutenant Governor, Member of the General Assembly and Representative in the 20 Congress of the United States, shall be filled by appointment by the 21 Governor. 22 23 SECTION 5. Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 29, Section 4, is amended 24 to read as follows: 25 § 4. Duration of term of appointee - Election to fill vacancy. 26 (a) The Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the 27 appointee shall serve during the entire unexpired term in the office in which 28 the vacancy occurs if such office would in regular course be filled at the 29 next General Election if no vacancy had occurred. If such office would not 30 in regular course be filled at such next general election the vacancy shall 31 be filled as follows: At the next General Election, if the vacancy occurs four months or more prior thereto, and at the second General Election after 32 the vacancy occurs if the vacancy occurs less than four months before the 33 34 next General Election after it occurs. The person so elected shall take 35 office on the 1st day of January following his election. 36 (b) An appointee to fill a vacancy in the office of Lieutenant

1	Governor shall serve during the entire unexpired term regardless of whether
2	the office would in regular course be filled at the next General Election if
3	no vacancy had occurred.

5	SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. (a) This amendment is effective on and
6	after January 1, 2019.
7	(b) A candidate for Lieutenant Governor shall run jointly with a
8	candidate for Governor, and his or her name shall appear jointly on the
9	ballot with the candidate for Governor, at the 2018 general election.
10	
11	SECTION 7. BALLOT TITLE AND POPULAR NAME. When this proposed
12	amendment is submitted to the electors of this state on the general election
13	ballot:
14	(1) The title of this joint resolution shall be the ballot
15	title; and
16	(2) The popular name shall be "A Constitutional Amendment
17	Concerning the Office of Lieutenant Governor and Amending the Method of
18	Election, Assignment of Duties, and Method of Filling a Vacancy for the
19	<u>Office of Lieutenant Governor".</u>
