8	PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION
9	CONCERNING ELECTED OFFICIALS; PROVIDING FOR TERMS OF
10	OFFICE FOR CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICIALS FOR FOUR (4)
11	YEARS; PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS SHALL
12	NOT BE APPOINTED OR ELECTED TO A CIVIL OFFICE DURING
13	THEIR ELECTED TERM; ALLOWING A CANDIDATE FOR AN
14	OFFICE TO BE CERTIFIED AS ELECTED WITHOUT APPEARING
15	ON THE BALLOT WHEN HE OR SHE IS THE ONLY CANDIDATE
16	FOR THE OFFICE AT THE ELECTION; AND DEFINING THE TERM
17	"INFAMOUS CRIME" FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING THE
18	ELIGIBILITY OF ELECTED OFFICIALS TO HOLD OFFICE.

23	CONSTITUTION CONCERNING THE TERMS,
24	ELECTION, AND ELIGIBILITY OF ELECTED
25	OFFICIALS.

28	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETIETH GENERAL
29	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL
30	MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:
31	
32	That the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
33	the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
34	for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives
35	and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
36	adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of

1	the State of Arkansas, to wit:
2	
3	SECTION 1. Arkansas Constitution, Article 3, is amended to add an
4	additional section to read as follows:
5	§ 13. Procedures for elections with one candidate.
6	(a) As used in this section, "election" means:
7	(1) A primary election;
8	(2) A special primary election;
9	(3) A general election; and
10	(4) A special election.
11	(b) The General Assembly may enact laws providing that if there is
12	only one (1) person qualified as a candidate for an office after all
13	deadlines for filing as a candidate have passed so that there will be only
14	one (1) name listed on the election ballot for the office and no write-in
15	candidates qualify to appear as candidates for the office on the election
16	<u>ballot:</u>
17	(1) The one (1) candidate for the office shall be declared
18	elected and his or her name shall not appear on the election ballot;
19	(2) The name of the candidate declared elected shall be
20	certified as elected in the same manner as if the candidate had been voted
21	upon at the election; and
22	(3) The election shall not be held if no other office or
23	issue is on the election ballot.
24	
25	SECTION 2. Arkansas Constitution, Article 5, § 9, is amended to read
26	as follows:
27	§ 9. Persons convicted ineligible.
28	(a) No person hereafter convicted of embezzlement of public money,
29	bribery, forgery, or other infamous crime, shall be is eligible to the
30	General Assembly or capable of holding any office of trust or profit in this
31	State <u>state</u> .
32	(b) As used in this section, "infamous crime" means:
33	(1) A felony offense;
34	(2) Abuse of office as defined under Arkansas law;
35	(3) Tampering as defined under Arkansas law; or
36	(4) A misdemeanor offense in which the finder of fact was

required to find, or the defendant to admit, an act of deceit, fraud, or 1 2 false statement, including without limitation a misdemeanor offense related 3 to the election process. 4 SECTION 3. Arkansas Constitution, Article 7, § 19, is amended to read 5 6 as follows: § 19. Circuit clerks - Election - Term of office - $\frac{Ex-officio}{Ex}$ 7 8 officio duties - County clerks elected in certain counties. 9 The clerks of the circuit courts shall be elected by the qualified 10 electors of the several counties for the term of two four (4) years, and shall be ex-officio ex officio clerks of the county and probate courts and 11 12 recorder; provided, that in any county having a population exceeding fifteen 13 thousand (15,000) inhabitants, as shown by the last Federal federal census, 14 there shall be elected a county clerk, in like manner as the clerk of the 15 circuit court, for the term of four (4) years, and in such case the county 16 clerk shall be ex-officio ex officio clerk of the probate court of such 17 county until otherwise provided by the General Assembly. 18 19 SECTION 4. Arkansas Constitution, Article 7, § 29, is amended to read 20 as follows: 21 § 29. County judge - Election - Term - Qualifications. 22 The Judge of the County Court judge of the county court shall be 23 elected by the qualified electors of the county for the term of two four (4) 24 years. He or she shall be at least twenty-five (25) years of age, a citizen 25 of the United States, a man an individual of upright character, of good 26 business education, and a resident of the State state for two (2) years 27 before his or her election; and a resident of the county at the time of his 28 or her election, and during his or her continuance in office. 29 30 SECTION 5. Arkansas Constitution, Article 7, § 46, is amended to read 31 as follows: 32 § 46. County executive officers - Compensation of county assessor. 33 The qualified electors of each county shall elect one (1) Sheriff 34 sheriff, who shall be ex officio ex officio collector of taxes, unless 35 otherwise provided by law; one (1) Assessor assessor, one (1) Coroner coroner, one (1) Treasurer treasurer, who shall be ex-officio ex officio

     duties as are now or may be prescribed by law: Provided, provided that no per

29	(1) The title of this joint resolution shall be the ballot

31	(2) The popular name shall be "PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE
32	ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION CONCERNING THE TERMS, ELECTION, AND ELIGIBILITY OF
33	ELECTED OFFICIALS".
