23	Arkansas, where she attended Emerson High School and served as Arkansas state
24	president, chapter president, and secretary of the FFA, formerly known as the
25	Future Farmers of America; and

27	WHEREAS, Miss Maloch was elected to the 2014-2015 National FFA Officer
28	team as National Secretary at the 87th National FFA Convention & Expo; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, Miss Maloch is the first female National FFA Officer from
31	Arkansas; and

33	WHEREAS, as National Secretary, Miss Maloch will spend a year traveling
34	over 100,000 national and international miles as she interacts with industry
35	leaders, corporate sponsors, government and education officials, FFA members
36	and teachers, and the surrounding communities; and

2	WHEREAS, Miss Maloch's duties as National Secretary include leading
3	personal growth and leadership training conferences for FFA members
4	throughout the country and setting policies to guide the National FFA
5	Organization and promote agricultural literacy; and

7	WHEREAS, some of Miss Maloch's achievements include the Outstanding
8	Sophomore Student award from the University of Arkansas Agricultural
9	Economics and Agribusiness Department in 2014, the Outstanding Freshman
10	Student award from the University of Arkansas Agricultural Economics and
11	Agribusiness Department in 2013, the Young Person of the Year award from the
12	Magnolia-Columbia County Chamber of Commerce in 2012, and the Horizon Award
13	from the South Arkansas Women's Network in 2012; and

15	WHEREAS, Miss Maloch was also selected as a Wallace-Carver Fellow, with
16	the United States Department of Agriculture in Washington, D.C., in 2014, a
17	fellowship that offers exceptional high school and college students the
18	opportunity to collaborate with world-renowned scientists and policymakers;

21	WHEREAS, Miss Maloch is a Bachelor of Science in Agriculture candidate
22	at the University of Arkansas Dale Bumpers College of Agricultural, Food and
23	Life Sciences in Fayetteville, Arkansas, majoring in Agricultural Business
24	with a Pre-Law concentration and is expected to graduate in the Spring of
25	2017; and

27	WHEREAS, Miss Maloch has participated in University of Arkansas Study
28	Abroad programs as an agricultural business team member in Nampula,
29	Mozambique, in 2014 and as a business team member in Dangriga, Belize, in
30	2013; and

32	WHEREAS, while Miss Maloch has traveled to 6 of the 7 continents, all
33	before the age of 20, she credits her experience growing up on a Brangus
34	cattle farm in Magnolia, Arkansas, for her invaluable lessons in
35	responsibility and service,
