11	TO EXPRESS SUPPORT OF THE FEDERAL TRANSFER OF PUBLIC
12	LANDS TO THE WESTERN STATES OF THE UNITED STATES; AND
13	TO URGE THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO ENGAGE IN GOOD
14	FAITH EFFORTS TO COORDINATE THE TRANSFER OF TITLE TO
15	THE WESTERN STATES.

19	TO EXPRESS SUPPORT OF THE FEDERAL
20	TRANSFER OF PUBLIC LANDS TO THE WESTERN
21	STATES OF THE UNITED STATES; AND TO URGE
22	THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO ENGAGE IN
23	GOOD FAITH EFFORTS TO COORDINATE THE
24	TRANSFER OF TITLE TO THE WESTERN STATES.

27	WHEREAS, under Article IV, Section 3, of the United States
28	Constitution, "The Congress shall have power to dispose of and make all
29	needful rules and regulations respecting the territory or other property
30	belonging to the United States"; and
31	
32	WHEREAS, the Constitutional Convention intended this provision to
33	transfer federal territorial lands only to create new states with the same
34 35	rights of sovereignty, freedom, and independence as the original states; and
36	WHEREAS over time states claiming federal territorial land ceded

1 their western land to the confederated Union to allow the confederated 2 government to dispose of the lands in order to create new states and apply 3 the net proceeds of any sales of the lands only to pay down the public debt; 4 and 5 6 WHEREAS, the United States Constitution contains no expression of 7 intent to authorize the federal government to indefinitely exercise control 8 over western public lands beyond the duty to manage the lands pending the 9 disposal of the lands to create new states; and therefore the lands should be 10 returned to the western states; and 11 12 WHEREAS, in order to promote legitimate federal interests, the western 13 states should upon transfer of the public lands directly to the state where 14 the public land is located, agree to affirmatively cede lands for the 15 National Park System, the National Wilderness Preservation System, and lands 16 reserved for federal military use, military parks, and military reservations 17 to the federal government under Article I, Section 8, Clause 17, of the 18 United States Constitution, on condition that the lands permanently remain 19 national park lands and that they not be sold, transferred, left in 20 substantial disrepair, or conveyed to any party other than to the state where 21 the land is located; and 22 23 WHEREAS, limiting the ability of western states to access and utilize

WHEREAS, limiting the ability of western states to access and utilize the public lands' natural resources within their borders has a negative impact on the economy of the western states and the economy of the entire United States; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide a fair, just, and equitable remedy for the federal government's past and continuing breaches of its solemn promises to the western states, the House of Representatives:

- 31 (1) Calls on the federal government to transfer title to all federal 32 public lands within the western states to the state where the land is 33 located;
  - (2) Urges the United States Congress to engage in good faith communication, cooperation, and consultation with the western states to coordinate the transfer of the public lands, and supports the western states

- l in these efforts;
- 2 (3) Calls on the western states to agree, upon transfer of the public
- 3 lands, to affirmatively cede to the federal government all lands currently
- 4 designated as part of the National Park System under 16 U.S.C. Section la-1,
- 5 the National Wilderness Preservation System under 16 U.S.C. Section 1131, or
- 6 for military use, military parks, or military reservations;
- 7 (4) Urges that if any public land in the western states be sold to
- 8 private owners, 95% of the net proceeds be paid to the Bureau of the Public
- 9 Debt to pay down the federal debt; and
- 10 (5) Calls on all other states of the United States to pass a similar
- 11 resolution in support of the transfer of the federal public lands to the
- 12 western states,

- 14 NOW THEREFORE,
- 15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETIETH GENERAL
- 16 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

17

- 18 THAT the House of Representatives expresses support to the western
- 19 states of the United States of America and the federal transfer of public
- 20 lands to the western states, and urges the United States Congress to engage
- 21 in good faith communication and cooperation to coordinate the transfer of
- 22 title to the western states.

- 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT upon adoption of this resolution an appropriate
- 25 copy be provided by the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives to the
- 26 United States Department of the Interior, the Majority Leader of the United
- 27 States Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, the
- 28 members of the Arkansas Congressional Delegation, and the governors, senate
- 29 presidents, and speakers of the house of representatives of the 49 other
- 30 states.
