1 (c) A feral hog captured by any means in accordance with under 2 subsection (a) of this section shall be immediately: 3 (1) Killed; or 4 (2)(A) Permanently identified by eartag approved by the Arkansas 5 Livestock and Poultry Commission and transported to a terminal facility that 6 is certified by the commission. 7 (B) A feral hog that is transported to a terminal facility 8 under subdivision  $(c)(2)(\Lambda)$  of this section is exempt from any requirements 9 for disease testing established by the commission. 10 (C) (B) The commission shall adopt regulations for the 11 issuance of a certification permit for a terminal facility and the 12 requirements for inspection of a terminal facility. 13 (C) A terminal facility shall: 14 (i) Maintain a record of each feral hog purchased, 15 including without limitation the: 16 (a) Name of the seller; 17 (b) Date of the purchase; 18 (c) Number of feral hogs purchased; and 19 (d) Eartag number issued for each feral hog 20 purchased; and 21 (ii) Comply with all swine regulations promulgated 22 by the commission. 23 (D) As used in this subsection, "terminal facility" means 24 a facility for the containment of domestic and feral hogs that requires that 25 a hog be killed before leaving the facility. 26 (E) A feral hog shall not be released into the wild under 27 any circumstances. 28 29 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 2-38-504(a), concerning penalties for releasing hogs into the wild, is amended to read as follows: 30 31 A person who knowingly releases or attempts to release a live hog (a) 32 upon public land upon conviction is guilty of an unclassified felony 33 misdemeanor and is subject to a fine of not less than one thousand dollars 34 (\$1,000) per hog nor more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per hog or imprisonment not to exceed two (2) years, or both and revocation of his or 35 36 her hunting and fishing rights in the state for up to five (5) years.

3	releasing hogs into the wild, is amended to add additional subsections to

5	(g) Any certified state law enforcement officer may write a citation		
6	for a violation under this section.		
7	(h) Fines collected under this section shall be deposited into the		
8	Game Protection Fund to be used for eradication efforts to eliminate feral		
9	hogs.		
10	(i) This section does not apply to the purchase, sale, receipt,		
11	possession, import, or transportation of a live feral hog that serves as a		
12	mascot for an institution of higher education.		
13			
14	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code Title 15, Chapter 42, Subchapter 1, is		
15	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:		
16	15-42-129. Resident feral hog depredation permit.		
17	(a) The Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission may issue a resident		
18	depredation permit for hunting and trapping feral hogs.		
19	(b) A person may obtain a depredation permit issued under this section		
20	by:		
21	(1) Applying to the commission; and		
22	(2) Furnishing information required by the commission to verify		
23	eligibility.		
24	(c) A depredation permit issued under this section shall:		
25	(1) Be in the same form and contain the same information as		
26	other depredation permits issued by the commission; and		
27	(2) Contain any other information required by the commission.		
28	(d) A property owner or tenant shall not be required to obtain a		
29	depredation permit issued under this section to hunt or trap feral hogs on		
30	the private property owned by the owner or leased by the tenant.		
31	(e) The commission may promulgate rules to implement this section.
