9	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AOC				
10	RESPONSIBILITY FOR COURT REPORTERS AND TRIAL COURT ADMINISTRATORS.				
11	(a) The Administrative Office of the Courts shall be responsible for				
12	the financial oversight of the Official Court Reporters of the Circuit Court				
13	and Trial Court Administrators, which shall include but not be limited to				
14	biennial and annual budget requests, all budgeting activities, monitoring				
15	expenses, travel, substitute expenses, indigent transcript payments and to				
16	ensure projected annual expenditures do not exceed total available funding.				
17	(b) The Administrative Office of the Courts with assistance from the				
18	Arkansas Judicial Council shall establish an official procedure or rules for				
19	all new hires, terminations and salary adjustments for Trial Court				
20	Administrators and Official Court Reporters. The official procedures or				
21	rules shall be implemented prior to July 1, 2015 and shall be administered				
22	for all Trial Court Administrators and Official Court Reporters.				
23	The provisions of this sections shall be in effect only from July 1 2015

28	FROM THE ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE FUND.				
29	(a) (i) The Administrative Office of the Courts shall be responsible				
30	for requesting and verifying the need for any additional appropriation, any				
31	position change level, and any increase in the Administration of Justice Fur				
32	Allocation Section as authorized annually through special language in the				
33	Department of Finance and Administration's Disbursing Act, for the Trial				
34	Court Administrators and Official Court Reporters.				
35	(ii) Any annual or biennial request for an increase in the				
36	Administration of Justice Fund allocation section for Trial Court				

- 1 Administrators and/or Official Court Reporters shall not exceed the total or
- 2 projected total revenues available for the Trial Court Administrator Fund or
- 3 <u>the Court Reporter's Fund from the Administration of Justice Fund as</u>
- 4 determined by the Administrative Office of the Courts with assistance from

- 15 <u>through June 30, 2016.</u>

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- 17 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. Any funds
- 19 appropriated by the Ninetieth General Assembly from the Trial Court
- 20 Administrative Assistant Fund may be deemed payable from the Trial Court
- 21 Administrator Fund.
- The provisions of this sections shall be in effect only from July 1 2015,
- 23 through June 30, 2016.

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- 25 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRIAL
- 27 COURT ADMINISTRATOR EMPLOYMENT. In the event that any Trial Court
- 28 Administrator terminates employment for any reason and is eligible for the
- 29 payment of accumulated annual leave, the employment date for the new employee
- 30 shall be delayed and the position shall remain vacant for the period of time
- 31 required to account for the cost of the payment of accumulated annual leave.
- 32 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
- 33 2014 2015 through June 30, 2015 2016.

- 35 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
- 36 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

1 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 2 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 3 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 4 5 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 6 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 7 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 8 9 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 10 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 11 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 12 13 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 14 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 15 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 16 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 17 18 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 19 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 20 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of 21 22 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 23 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm 24 25 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 26 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 27 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015. 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35

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
