26	SECTION 1. Arkansas Co	ode § 24-7-716 is repeale	d.
27	24-7-716. Lump-sum payn	ment of reserve value of	small annuity.
28	(a) The Arkansas Teacher Retirement System may pay the reserve value		
29	of any annuity benefit to a retirant or beneficiary when the annuity amount		
30	is less than twenty dollars (\$20.00) per month, except that the consent of		
31	the payee shall be required if the payment exceeds one thousand seven hundred		
32	fifty dollars (\$1,750).		
33	(b) The reserve value shall be the actuarial equivalent of the annuity		
34	otherwise payable.		
35	(c) Any lump-sum payment so made shall be a complete discharge of all		
36	liability under the system wi	ith respect to the annuit	<del>.y .</del>

2	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
3	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain provisions of the		
4	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System Act are in need of revision and updating		
5	to maintain the teacher retirement laws in conformance with sound public		
6	pension policy; that the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System, a state agency		
7	created by the General Assembly for the purpose of providing retirement		
8	benefits to school employees of the state, operates on a fiscal year of July		
9	1 to June 30; that having a July 1, 2015, effective date is necessary to		
10	allow the provisions within this act to begin on the first day of the fiscal		
11	year to provide proper administration of the procedures herein; that such		
12	revisions and updating are of great importance for actuarial purposes and to		
13	protect the benefits to members of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System;		
14	and that this act is immediately necessary in order to maintain an orderly		
15	system of benefits for the members of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System.		
16	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act, being necessary		
17	for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, shall become		
18	effective on or before July 1, 2015.
