10 WINE, SPIRITS, AND MALT LIQUOR; TO AUTHORIZE A REFUND
11 OF TWENTY-ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$21,000) TO
12 SUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS AND TWENTY-THREE THOUSAND
13 (\$23,000) DOLLARS TO UNSUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS; AND FOR
14 OTHER PURPOSES.

18 TO REQUIRE A PERMIT FEE OF TWENTY-FIVE
19 THOUSAND DOLLARS WITH REFUNDS OF TWENTY-
20 ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS TO SUCCESSFUL
21 APPLICANTS AND TWENTY-THREE THOUSAND
22 DOLLARS TO UNSUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-4-208(i), concerning fees for
28 applications for permits to sell vinous (except small farm wines),
29 spirituous, or malt liquor, is amended to read as follows:

30 (i)(1) There shall be an initial application fee of ~~two thousand~~
31 ~~dollars (\$2,000)~~ twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000).

32 (2) If an applicant is successful in his or her application,
33 twenty-one thousand dollars (\$21,000) of that sum shall be refunded.

34 (3) In the event if an applicant is not successful in his or her
35 application, ~~one thousand dollars (\$1,000)~~ twenty-three thousand dollars
36 (\$23,000) of that sum shall be refunded.
