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| 26  | SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 24, Chapter 4, Subchapter 2, is amended                        |
| 27  | to add an additional section to read as follows:  |
| 28  | 24-4-213. Eligibility of participating employers in the Arkansas                              |
| 29  | Public Employees' Retirement System that are not agencies or                                  |
| 30  | instrumentalities of the State of Arkansas.   |
| 31  | (a) To ensure the tax-qualified status of the Arkansas Public                                 |
| 32  | Employees' Retirement System under the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C. § 1                   |
| 33  | et seq., the Arkansas Municipal League shall take the following actions by                    |
| 34  | <u>July 1, 2015:</u>  |
| 35  | (1) Comply with the fiscal management laws of the State of                                    |
| 36  | Arkansas and submit to audits by the Division of Legislative Audit under the                  |

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| 2  | <u>seq.;</u>  |
| 3  | (2) Comply with the accounting and budgetary laws governing                   |

| 5  | Budgetary Procedures Law, § 19-4-101 et seq., and receive an appropriation    |
| 6  | for the expenditures of the Arkansas Municipal League from the General        |
| 7  | Assembly in the same manner as state agencies; and                            |
| 8  | (3) Comply with the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act,              |
| 9  | § 21-5-201 et seq.  |
| 10 | (b) If the Arkansas Municipal League fails to comply with subsection          |
| 11 | (a) of this section by July 1, 2015:  |
| 12 | (1) Current and former employees of the Arkansas Municipal                    |
| 13 | League shall be removed from the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement        |
| 14 | System;   |
| 15 | (2) Employees of the Arkansas Municipal League not yet vested in              |
| 16 | the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System shall receive a refund of    |
| 17 | their contributions;  |
| 18 | (3) Retirement service credit for employees of the Arkansas                   |

| 29 | SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the                |
| 30 | General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Arkansas Public Employees' |
| 31 | Retirement System must meet certain federal criteria to ensure the tax-       |
| 32 | qualified status of the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System under    |
| 33 | the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C. § 1 et seq.; and that this act is        |
| 34 | immediately necessary to ensure that the Arkansas Public Employees'           |
| 35 | Retirement System meets these criteria and maintains its tax-qualified        |
| 36 | status. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being      |

| 1  | immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and |
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| 2  | safety shall become effective on:   |
| 3  | (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;                               |
| 4  | (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,             |
| 5  | the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the |
| 6  | bill; or  |
| 7  | (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is                   |
| 8  | overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto                      |
