32	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are prov	ided, and that in
33	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the de	lay in the
34	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work ir	reparable harm
35	upon the proper administration and provision of essential go	<u>vernmental</u>
36	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exis	t and this Act
