3	(a) A person committed to An inmate of the Department of Correction \underline{o}		
4	Department of Community Correction who is earning at least minimum wage and		
5	is employed pursuant to <u>under</u> §§ 12-30-501 and 12-30-502 shall have his or		
6	her wages set aside in a separate wage fund by the warden or supervisor of		
7	the facility in a separate wage fund in which the inmate is incarcerated.		
8	(b) The Director of the Department of Correction and the Director of		
9	the Department of Community Correction shall promulgate regulations which		
10	will rules that:		
11	(1) Protect the inmate's rights to due process;		
12	(2) Provide for hearings as necessary before the Crime Victims		
13	Reparations Board; and		
14	(3) Govern the disposition of a confined person's an inmate's		
15	gross monthly wage, minus required payroll deductions and payment of		
16	necessary work-related incidental expenses, for the following purposes:		
17	(A) The $\underline{\text{To}}$ support of families the family and dependent		
18	relatives of the respective inmates inmate;
