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20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-21-108(b), concerning donations of school
23	district property, is amended to read as follows:
24	(b)(1) If the board of directors for a school district determines that
25	real property owned or controlled by the school district is not required for
26	the present or future needs of the school district and that the donation of
27	the real property would serve a beneficial educational service for the
28	citizens of the school district, then the school district may donate real
29	property to a publicly supported institution of higher education, a technical
30	institute, a community college, a not-for-profit organization, a county, a
31	city, an incorporated town, the Department of Correction, the Department of
32	Community Correction, or any entity thereof for the following limited
33	purposes:
34	(A) Having the real property preserved, improved, upgraded,
35	rehabilitated, or enlarged by the donee;
36	(B) Providing a publicly supported institution of higher

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1	education, a technical institute, or a community college with the donated
2	property in which to hold classes; or
3	(C) Providing community programs and beneficial educational
4	services, social enrichment programs, or after-school programs.
5	(2) A school district may donate the fee simple title and
6	absolute interest in real property, without any reservations or restrictions
7	to the real property, to a publicly supported institution of higher learning,
8	a technical institute, a community college, a not-for-profit organization, a
9	county, $rac{\Theta au}{2}$ a city, an incorporated town, the Department of Correction, the
10	Department of Community Correction, or any entity thereof.
11	(3) If two (2) years after the effective date of consolidation
12	the real property of the consolidated school district is not used by the
13	school district for educational purposes and has not been sold, preserved,
14	leased, or donated, the school district board of directors shall make the

16	education, a technical institute, a community college, a not-for-profit
