1	SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - REAPPROPRIATION - CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS
2	FUND. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Senate, to be payable
3	from the Constitutional Officers Fund, for the balance remaining on June 30,
4	2015 in the appropriations enacted to defray the necessary expenses of the
5	Arkansas Senate of the Ninetieth General Assembly, Section 3 of Act 1 of
6	2014, Sections 4 and 5 of Act 3 of 2014, and Act 2 of 2015 there to be used
7	for the same purpose for the Arkansas Senate of the Ninetieth General
8	Assembly, in a sum in the aggregate not to exceed\$2,400,000.
9	
10	SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - REAPPROPRIATION - STATE CENTRAL SERVICES
11	FUND. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Senate, to be payable
12	from the State Central Services Fund, for the balance remaining on June 30,
13	2015 in the appropriations enacted to defray the necessary expenses of the
14	Arkansas Senate of the Ninetieth General Assembly, Sections 3, 6, 7 and 8 of
15	Act 3 of 2014, there to be used for the same purposes for the Arkansas Senate
16	of the Ninetieth General Assembly, in a sum in the aggregate not to
17	exceed\$2,400,000.
18	
19	SECTION 7. APPROPRIATION - COMPUTERIZATION. There is hereby
20	appropriated, to the Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the State Central
21	Services Fund, for expenses necessary in continuing the computerization of
22	the legislative process in the Arkansas Senate, the sum of\$700,000.
23	
24	SECTION 8. APPROPRIATION - RENOVATIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS. There is
25	hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the State
26	Central Services Fund, for construction, improvements, renovations and
27	equipping of the Arkansas Senate facilities and other purposes of the
28	Arkansas Senate, the sum of\$700,000.
29	
30	SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
31	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
32	TRANSFERS. If the Senate Efficiency Committee and the Secretary of the
33	Senate, subject to the approval of the Arkansas Senate, should determine that
34	any item or portion thereof appropriated herein for a specific purpose is not
35	needed for such purpose, the Secretary of the Senate may certify such fact to
36	the State Auditor and the State Auditor shall cause a transfer to be made

from one item to another.

SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SALARIES. In order that exceptionally well-qualified personnel may be recruited and retained, the Senate may exceed the maximum salary levels by no more than twenty percent (20%) for no more than one-third (1/3) of the positions authorized in their operation appropriation act, and may exceed the maximum salary levels for the purpose of merit adjustments for all positions.

SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm
