1 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PARK BUDGET ALLOCATION. Prior to July 1 of each fiscal year, the Legislative 3 4 Council or the Joint Budget Committee shall review the Parks and Tourism 5 Department's plan for the upcoming year of amounts to be disbursed for each 6 park or other entity from the funds appropriated for State Operations of this 7 Act. The request for review from the agency shall include amounts to be 8 disbursed for each entity for the upcoming fiscal year compared to the 9 current fiscal year's anticipated expenditures and the previous fiscal year's 10 actual expenditures with any additional detail as may be required by the 11 reviewing body.
