30	(a)(1) Annually, beginning June 30, 2016, the Department of Wor	kforce
31	Services shall prepare or contract with an entity to prepare an econom	<u>ic</u>

34	(2) The report shall be made available online and shall b	<u>'e</u>

2	(B) Use data available to the Department of Higher
3	Education relating to the employment and earnings of graduates of degree or
4	certificate programs from a state-supported institution of higher education;
5	(C) Use an integrated postsecondary education data system
6	for calculating the average student loan debt of a graduate of a degree or
7	certificate program from a state-supported institution of higher education;
8	(D) Include data on the employment of graduates of a
9	degree or certificate program from a state-supported institution of higher
10	education beginning the year after the degree or certificate is earned,
11	including graduates employed full-time, by:
12	(i) Number; and
13	(ii) Percentage; and
14	(E) Include data on the earnings of graduates of a degree
15	or certificate program at a state-supported institution of higher education
16	beginning the year after the degree or certificate is earned, on an annual

19	institution of higher education shall provide an enrolled student with
20	electronic access to the economic security report of employment and earnings

23	(c)(1) Annually, beginning July 1, 2016, a four-year state-supported
24	institution of higher education shall provide an enrolled student with
25	electronic access to the economic security report of employment and earnings
26	outcomes prepared by the Department of Workforce Services before the student
27	registers for classes.
28	(2) Each four-year state-supported institution of higher
29	education shall provide each student electronic access to the following
30	information annually before the student registers for classes:
31	(A) The top twenty-five percent (25%) of degrees reported
32	by the four-year state-supported institution of higher education in terms of
33	the highest full-time job placement and highest average annual earnings in
34	the year after degree completion; and
35	(B) The bottom ten percent (10%) of degrees reported by
36	the four-year state-supported institution of higher education in terms of the
