4	(b)(1) A person commits criminal impersonation in the second degree if		
5	the person does an act in his or her pretended or assumed capacity or		
6	character with the purpose to injure, defraud, harass, or intimidate another		
7	person and the actor:		
8	(A) Assumes a false identity;		
9	(B) Pretends to be a representative of a person or		
10	organization;		
11	(C) Pretends to be an officer or employee of the		
12	government other than a law enforcement officer described in subsection (a)		
13	of this section;		
14	(D) Pretends that he or she is a law enforcement officer		
15	when the person is not a law enforcement officer; or		
16	(E) Pretends to have a handicap or disability.		
17	(2) Criminal impersonation in the second degree is a:		
18	(A) Class D felony if:		
19	(i) The victim of the offense is an animal owner;		
20	and		
21	(ii) An animal of the owner is seized as a result of		
22	the offense; or		
23	(B) Class A misdemeanor if otherwise committed.		
24	(c) As used in this section:		
25	(1) "Animal" means the same as defined in § 5-62-102; and		
26	(2) "Owner" means the same as defined in $\S 5-62-102$.		
27	(d) A circuit court or district court in which a charge is filed under		
28	subsection (a) of this section shall immediately order the removal of any
