1 An insolvent cemetery grant fund is established within the general 2 operating fund of the Arkansas Cemetery Board for the care, maintenance, and 3 operation and improvement of a perpetual care cemetery that has been: 4 (1) Declared insolvent by a state or federal court; and 5 (2) Acquired by and is controlled by a state, county, or 6 municipal government or by a nonprofit organization as defined by § 501(c)(3) 7 of the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C. § 501(c)(3) is insolvent or in 8 financial distress as determined by the Arkansas Cemetery Board. 9 10 SECTION 2.
