- 19 forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the
- 20 Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;
- 21 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall
- 22 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward by the
- 23 September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting
- 24 which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or
- 25 Institution and the amount of the funding carried forward, the program name
- or line item, the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the
- 27 written request set forth in (1) above;
- 28 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
- 29 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
- 30 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
- 31 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
- 32 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
- 33 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
- 34 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
- 35 Committee; and
- 36 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include

all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals and/or a

statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution.

SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND

BALANCE TRANSFER. Upon the effective date of this act, the available

balances received by the Arkansas Science and Technology Authority from

Client Services provided through the Arkansas Manufacturing Extension Network

Federal appropriation, shall be transferred to the Arkansas Manufacturing

Extension Network — Cash Fund Account.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  $\frac{2014}{14}$  through June 30,  $\frac{2015}{2016}$ .

SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

18 APPROPRIATION AND FUND TRANSFERS. After receiving approval from the Chief

19 Fiscal Officer of the State, the Director of the Arkansas Science and

20 Technology Authority is authorized to transfer appropriation and funds from

21 the State Operations - Arkansas Acceleration Fund Programs line item within

22 the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account to the Arkansas Acceleration Fund.

23 The total of all transfers shall not exceed \$3,500,000.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  $\frac{2014}{1}$  2015 through June 30,  $\frac{2015}{1}$  2016.

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SECTION 18. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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1	SECTION $19$ . LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
2	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
3	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
4	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
5	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
6	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
7	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
8	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
9	
10	SECTION 20. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
11	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
12	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
13	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of
14	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
15	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
16	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm
17	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
18	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
19	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
20	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
