22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-16-801(a)(2), concerning information
25 required to be on a person's driver's license, is amended to read as follows:

26 (2) Each license shall include:

27 (A) A distinguishing number assigned to the licensee;

28 (B)(i) Except as provided under subdivision (a)(2)(B)(ii)
29 of this section, the name, residence address, date of birth, and a brief
30 description of the licensee.

31 (ii) The following exceptions to providing a
32 residence address and instead providing a post office box address shall be
33 allowed at the option of the licensee:

34 (a) If the licensee is a law enforcement
35 officer; or

36 (b) If the licensee is a victim of domestic



violence or the dependent of a victim of domestic violence as provided under
 § 27-16-811, ~~and~~.

(iii) If the licensee is an elected prosecuting attorney or a duly appointed deputy prosecuting attorney, he or she may use a post office box address or his or her office address instead of his or her residence address; and

(C) A space upon which the licensee may affix his or her signature.
