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2	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
3	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that this act adds two (2) new		
4	members to the Arkansas Racing Commission; that these members are necessary		
5	to allow the commission to perform its powers and duties in an effective and		
6	efficient manner; and that this act should become effective at the earliest		
7	opportunity to expedite the appointment of the new members of the commission.		
8	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately		
9	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall		
10	become effective on:		
11	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
12	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
13	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
14	bill; or		
15	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
16	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.		
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
