SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD. Notwithstanding any law pertaining to the transfer of year-end fund balances or any law to the contrary, any funds which remain in the Department of Education Fund Account at the end of a fiscal year shall remain in the Department of Education Fund Account and made available to fund appropriation authorized by law and made payable from the Department of Education Fund

31 Account for the following fiscal year.

Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions:

(1) Prior to June  $30, \frac{2015}{}$  2016 the Agency shall by written statement set forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

- 1 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall

  - (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.

SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SALARY OF THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION. It is the intent of the General Assembly that the appropriation for the salary of the Commissioner of the Department of Education shall be the sole and exclusive authority for his or her salary. It is further the intent of the General Assembly that the Commissioner be required to devote all of his or her working time exclusively to the performance of his or her duties as Commissioner of the Department of Education. Therefore, the Commissioner of the Department of Education is hereby prohibited from accepting any additional salary from any other source (including state, federal, or private entities or persons) for the performance of his or her duties as Commissioner, and is prohibited from accepting any salary, fees or compensation from any other source (including state, federal or private entities or persons) for any other employment of

- l any kind outside the scope of his or her duties as Commissioner, including
- 2 but not limited to consulting work for any other public or private entity.
- 3 This section shall not be construed to prohibit the Commissioner from
- 4 accepting or receiving expense reimbursements and employee benefits as
- 5 provided by State law.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,

  7 2015 through June 30, 2016.

- 9 SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 11 ESTABLISHMENT OF A "POSITION POOL".
- 12 (a) To address needs emerging from statewide education issues and the
- 13 necessity of recruiting and retaining qualified personnel, the Arkansas
- 14 Department of Education or its successor agency is authorized for the 2014-
- $\frac{2015}{2015}$   $\frac{2015-2016}{2015}$  fiscal year a pool of no more than five (5)
- 16 Professional/Executive positions at a salary not to exceed the maximum salary
- 17 for a grade N912. These positions are to be used by the Department of
- 18 Education in the event that the personal services needs of the Department
- 19 during the  $\frac{2014-2015}{2015-2016}$  fiscal year require additional positions,
- 20 either by title or in number, that are not authorized by the General Assembly
- 21 in Section 1 of this Act. These positions may also be used to properly
- 22 classify positions when the Department does not have a vacant position
- 23 available with the appropriate title and salary level.
- 24 (b) To address needs emerging from statewide education issues and the
- 25 necessity of recruiting and retaining qualified personnel, the Arkansas
- 26 Department of Education or its successor agency is authorized for the 2014-
- 27 <del>2015</del> 2015-2016 fiscal year a pool of twenty-five (25) classified positions at
- 28 up to a grade C130. These positions are to be used by the Department of
- 29 Education in the event that the personal services needs of the Department
- 30 during the 2014-2015 2015-2016 fiscal year require additional positions,
- 31 either by classification or in number, that are not authorized by the General
- 32 Assembly in Section 1 of this Act. These positions may also be used to
- 33 properly classify positions when the Department does not have a vacant
- 34 position available with the appropriate title and grade level.
- 35 (c) Any salary determinations or adjustments administered under the 36 provisions of Subsections (a) and (b) of this Section shall be made by

- comparing the qualifications and salary levels of similar employees in school districts or in other state education agencies.
  - (d) The Department of Education is authorized to access the pool positions authorized in this Section at any time when it is determined by the Commissioner that the need exists. The Commissioner shall provide a quarterly report of the justification for the need to allocate titles from this growth pool to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and to the Arkansas Legislative Council for review. The report shall also include an accounting of the names, titles, and salaries of personnel whose salaries have been adjusted under provisions of Subsections (a) and (b) of this Section.
  - (e) If the Department of Education requests continuation of any "Position Pool" position(s) as established herein during the next fiscal year, the position(s) must be requested as a new position(s) in the agency's budget request.
  - (f) Determining the number of personnel to be employed by a state agency is the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually accomplished by delineating the maximum number of personnel by identifying job titles and the maximum grade or salary attached to those titles. The General Assembly has determined that the Arkansas Department of Education could be operated more efficiently if some flexibility is given to that agency. That flexibility is being accomplished by providing a position pool in Subsections (a) and (b) of this Section and since the General Assembly has granted the agency broad powers under the growth pool concept, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the position pool by requiring review of the Legislative Council in the utilization of the position pool. Therefore, the requirement of review by the Legislative Council is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of review by the Legislative Council is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2014

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2015 through June 30, 2015 2016.

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SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS LEADERSHIP ACADEMY - REDUCTION OF FUNDS RESTRICTION. Upon determination by the Department of Education that a reduction in the amount of available

- 1 appropriation within the Department of Education Fund Account is required
- 2 from the amount appropriated, the reduction in the available appropriation
- 3 from the full amount appropriated for the Arkansas Leadership Academy shall
- 4 be limited to the average percentage reduction in the other appropriations to
- 5 the Department of Education from the Department of Education Fund Account.
- 6 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, -20147 2015 through June 30, 2015 2016.

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- SECTION 24. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 11 LEADERSHIP ACADEMY. The funds appropriated in the "AR LEADERSHIP ACADEMY"
- 12 line item in Section 3 of this Act shall be used for the School Support
- 13 Program which will provide support to schools or school districts designated
- 14 by the Department of Education as being in school improvement status and to
- 15 provide for general operations of the Leadership Academy.
- 16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2014
- 17 2015 through June 30, 2015 2016.

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- 19 SECTION 25. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

- 21 FUND RESTRICTIONS. No state funds shall be used for abortion referral in
- 22 public schools, or for abortion services. Funds shall be expended in

- 24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  $\frac{2014}{1}$

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- 27 SECTION 26. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

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10	SECTION 28. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
11	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
12	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
13	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of
14	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
15	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
16	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm
17	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
18	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
19	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
20	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
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
