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## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO ENSURE THAT A SCHOOL DISTRICT IS NOT IN  
9 VIOLATION OF THE STANDARDS OF ACCREDITATION FOR  
10 ARKANSAS PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND SCHOOL DISTRICTS IF A  
11 SCHOOL DISTRICT OFFERS A COURSE BUT NO STUDENTS  
12 ENROLL IN THE COURSE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.  
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## Subtitle

15 TO ENSURE THAT A SCHOOL DISTRICT IS NOT  
16 IN VIOLATION OF THE STANDARDS OF  
17 ACCREDITATION FOR ARKANSAS PUBLIC SCHOOLS  
18 AND SCHOOL DISTRICTS IF A SCHOOL DISTRICT  
19 OFFERS A COURSE BUT NO STUDENTS ENROLL IN  
20 THE COURSE.  
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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-15-213 is amended to read as follows:

27 6-15-213. Course considered as taught under certain circumstances.

28 (a) If A course shall be considered as taught by a school district in  
29 compliance with the Standards of Accreditation of Arkansas Public Schools and  
30 School Districts if:

31 (1) a A course required to be taught by a school district under  
32 the State Board of Education's Standards for Accreditation of Arkansas Public  
33 Schools and School Districts ~~has~~:

34 (A) Has an enrollment of one (1) or more students and all  
35 students enrolled in the course leave the school district or drop the course  
36 after the course has commenced but before the completion of the course in



1 each given school year or school semester the course is to be taught ~~and if~~  
 2 ~~no other students that are eligible to take the course enroll to attend the~~  
 3 ~~school district campus where the course is required to be taught, the course~~  
 4 ~~shall be considered as taught by the school district in compliance with the~~  
 5 ~~standards for accreditation under the following conditions; or~~

6 (B) The school district made the course available to  
 7 students as required but no students signed up to take the course;

8 ~~(1)~~(2) The school district superintendent certifies in writing  
 9 that no student eligible to take the required course enrolled to attend the  
 10 school district campus where the course was required to be taught after the  
 11 initial student or students left the school district or that no eligible  
 12 student enrolled in the course offered by the school district;

13 ~~(2)~~(3) The school district provides written proof, as required by  
 14 the Department of Education, that the school district had the course  
 15 scheduled to be taught on the school district’s master course schedule during  
 16 the entire time the course was required to be taught;

17 ~~(3)~~(4) The school district provides written proof, as required by  
 18 the department, that the school district had a properly licensed teacher  
 19 employed and able to teach the required course during the entire time the  
 20 course was required to be taught and the course was listed on the school  
 21 district’s master course schedule;

22 ~~(4)~~(5) The department, upon review of proper records of the  
 23 school district and information certified by the school district  
 24 superintendent, confirms that the school district satisfied the requirements  
 25 of subdivisions (a)(1)-(3) of this section and verifies that the information  
 26 submitted pursuant to subdivisions (a)(1)-(3) of this section is correct; and

27 ~~(5)(A)~~(6)(A) At the end of the school semester in which the  
 28 course was required to be taught, the school district petitions the state  
 29 board in writing for a waiver of the standards for accreditation requirement  
 30 that the particular course be taught for that school semester.

31 (B)(i) The superintendent and the school district board  
 32 president of the school district seeking the waiver shall appear before the  
 33 state board to present their request for a waiver.

34 (ii) Representatives of the department shall appear  
 35 before the state board to confirm and verify the information required to be  
 36 filed with the department under this section.

1 (b)(1) Upon satisfaction of the requirements of subsection (a) of this  
2 section, the state board shall waive the requirement that the course be  
3 taught on a semester basis and the school district shall not be cited for a  
4 violation of the Standards of Accreditation for Arkansas Public Schools and  
5 School Districts with respect to this issue.

6 (2) The state board shall waive the requirement for only the  
7 semester in which the student or students left the school district or the  
8 course was offered by the school district and no students enrolled.

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
