35	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,			
36	to the Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners, to be payable from the cash

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19 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS 21 STATE DENTAL EXAMINERS BOARD EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEYS. None of the funds 22 appropriated in this Act for Maintenance and General Operation shall be 23 expended in payment for services of attorneys, unless the agency shall first 24 make a request in writing to the Attorney General of the State of Arkansas to 25 provide the required legal services. The Attorney General's Office shall 26 provide the requested legal services, or, if the Attorney General's Office 27 shall determine that sufficient personnel are not available to provide the 28 requested legal services, the Attorney General shall certify the same to the 29 agency and may authorize the agency to employ legal counsel and to expend 30 monies appropriated for Maintenance and General Operations therefore, if: 31 The Attorney General determines, and certifies in writing, that such (1)

32 agency needs the advice or assistance of legal counsel, and 33 (2) The Attorney General consents in writing to the employment of the

34 legal counsel to be retained by the agency, and

35 The Attorney General determines receives confirmation in writing from (3) 36 the Agency that the agency will re-advertises annually for legal counsel if

outside legal counsel is hired and that any amount to be paid for outside
legal counsel has been will be reviewed and approved by the Arkansas
Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

4 Such certification shall be required with respect to each instance of the 5 employment of special legal counsel, or shall be required annually with 6 respect to legal counsel employed on a retainer basis. A copy of such 7 certification shall be entered in the official minutes of the agency, and 8 shall be retained in the fiscal records of the agency for audit purposes. 9 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 10 11 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 12 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 13 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 14 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 15 has determined that the Arkansas State Dental Examiners Board may operate 16 more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Arkansas State Dental 17 Examiners Board authorizing broad powers under this section. Therefore, it is 18 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight 19 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 20 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the 21 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this 22 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint 23 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void. 24 25 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,

26 2015 through June 30, 2016.

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28 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 29 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 30 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 31 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 32 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 33 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 34 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 35 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 36 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
