## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION TO A TEACHER IN GRADES SEVEN THROUGH TWELVE (7-12) WHO ELECTS TO TEACH MORE THAN THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF STUDENTS PERMITTED UNDER THE STANDARDS FOR ACCREDITATION OF ARKANSAS PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND SCHOOL DISTRICTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

> TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION TO A TEACHER IN GRADES SEVEN THROUGH TWELVE $(7-12)$ WHO ELECTS TO TEACH MORE THAN THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF STUDENTS PERMITTED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 17, Subchapter 8, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-17-812. Compensation for teaching more than the maximum number of students permitted.
(a) If a teacher in grades seven through twelve (7-12) volunteers to teach more than the maximum number of students permitted per day under the Standards for Accreditation of Arkansas Public Schools and School Districts, then the teacher's pay under his or her contract shall be increased by an amount proportionate to the teacher's base pay and the additional number of students taught by the teacher.
(b) A teacher is not required to teach more than the maximum number of students permitted per day under the Standards for Accreditation of Arkansas

Public Schools and School Districts.
(c) A school district shall adopt a policy to implement this section.
