30	(1) "Branch campus of the community college" means an			
31	institution with facilities located apart from the community college campus			
32	but within the community college district;

1 alteration, addition, or enlargement of buildings or other structures; and 2 (iii) The initial purchase of library holdings, furniture, apparatuses, and other equipment for a new or expanded facility as 3 4 defined by the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board. 5 (B) "Capital outlay expense" excludes those expenses used 6 for maintenance and replacement of equipment and furniture; 7 (3) "Community college" means an institution of higher education 8 established or to be established under the provisions of this chapter 9 dedicated primarily to the educational needs of the service area and offering 10 a comprehensive program, including, but without limitation, vocational, 11 trade, and technical specialty courses and programs, college transfer 12 courses, and courses in general adult education; 13 (4) "Department" means the Department of Higher Education; 14 (5) "District" means the geographic area located within one (1) 15 or more counties or cities or any described combination thereof or any 16 described area which that may be in one (1) or more counties or parts of 17 counties but within the same service area which boundary that is directly 18 responsible for the local financial support and local administration of an 19 institution located within its service area; 20 (6)(5) "Existing community college" means a community college 21 established in accordance with the provisions of and presently operating in 22 conformity with Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 52, and §§ 6-61-101 - 6-61-23 103, 6-61-201 - 6-61-209, 6-61-212 - 6-61-216, 6-61-301 - 6-61-305, 6-61-401,6-61-402, 6-61-501 - 6-61-524, and 6-61-601 - 6-61-603; 24 25 (7)(6) "Local board" means the governing body of a technical 26 college or community college; 27 (8)(A)(A) "Operating expense" means those educational and 28 general funds devoted to or required for the regular or ordinary expense of 29 the college, including administrative, maintenance, and salary expenses but 30 excluding capital outlay expenses, student activity expenses, and expenses 31 for intercollegiate athletics. 32 (B) "Operating expense" includes maintenance and 33 replacement of furniture and equipment, including motor vehicles; 34 (9)(8) "Satellite campus" means an institution or off-campus facility of a community college located within a service area of a technical 35

1 $(10)(\Lambda)$ "Service area" means the geographic area assigned by the 2 Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board as the area to be served by the 3 institution located within its borders. 4 (B) Each county in the state shall be assigned to at least 5 one (1) service area; 6 (11) "State board", "board", or "full board" means the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board; 7 8 (12)(9) "System institution" means a technical college or 9 community college; and 10 (13)(10) "Technical college" means an institution of higher 11 education established under this chapter dedicated primarily to the 12 educational needs of the service area and offering a comprehensive program, 13 including, but without limitation, vocational, trade, and technical specialty 14 courses and programs, courses in general adult education, and courses 15 comparable in content and quality to freshman and sophomore courses which 16 that may carry transfer credit to a four-year institution in a chosen course 17 of study. 18 19 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-53-203(a)(2), concerning the duties and 20 powers of the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board, is repealed. 21 (2) To determine service areas containing all counties within 22 the state and to recommend adoption of such service areas to the full board, 23 who shall designate which system institution within the service area shall be responsible for fulfillment of the two year postsecondary educational needs 24 25 of the service area; 26 27 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-53-301(e), concerning the Arkansas 28 Technical and Community College System, is amended to read as follows: 29 The local board shall be responsible for the administration and (e) operation of the institution and shall be further responsible for the 30 31 provision of services to meet the two-year postsecondary educational needs of 32 those citizens located within the service area of the institution state. 33 34 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 6-53-302(c), concerning local 35 administration, is amended to read as follows: 36 (c) Members of the local board shall be qualified electors of the

Arkansas Code §§ 6-53-304 - 6-53-306 are amended to read as 5 follows: 6 6-53-304. Student tuition - Fees. 7 (a) The intent of this chapter is to make technical and community 8 college programs available to as many citizens of Arkansas as possible. To 9 this end, tuition and fees should be maintained at a reasonable level so as 10 not to exclude citizens because of cost. 11 (b) The local board shall determine the minimum student tuition and 12 fees to be charged by institutions within the system. (c) The local board shall set both in-district and out-of-district 13 14 student tuition and fees for each institution within its service area 15 district. Students residing outside a community college district may be 16 subject to extra tuition and fees. 17 18 6-53-305. Transportation. 19 A technical or community college may establish and operate a 20 transportation system for students within the service area district of the 21 institution assigned by the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board. 22 23 6-53-306. Coordination with secondary vocational-technical education 24 and literacy programs. 25 Upon the approval of the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board, 26 the local board may contract with the Department of Career Education, a 27 nonprofit organization, or a local school district board of directors within 28 its service area to offer secondary-level vocational and technical courses 29 and programs, adult literacy courses, and industry training. 30 31 SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 6-53-402(b)-(e), concerning two-year 32 branches, is amended to read as follows: 33 (b) Upon approval by the board and the Higher Learning Commission and 34 upon assignment of a service area for the institution, the two-year branch 35 campus shall be known as a technical college. (c) All records, personnel, property, unexpended balances of 36

3 (d) Upon the appointment of a local board, all records, personnel,
4 property, unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations, or other funds

6 (e) The local board shall be responsible for the administration and 7 operation of the technical college and such other state-supported 8 institutions within the system located in the service area designated by the 9 state board as necessary to adequately meet the two-year postsecondary 10 educational needs of those citizens-located within the service area assigned 11 to the technical college.

13 SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 6-53-403(b), concerning technical colleges
14 and two-year branches, is amended to read as follows:

(b) Prior to the election, the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall assist any group of citizens representing a proposed community college district within the service area containing the technical college in determining the feasibility of the proposed district and the adequacy of the proposed millage levy, if any.

21 SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 6-53-404(a)-(c), concerning technical 22 colleges, is amended to read as follows:

(a) A board of trustees of a community college may, by resolution or
when requested, petition the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board to
accept a technical college located in the same service area to be a branch
campus of the community college.

(b) All records, personnel, property, unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations, or other funds of above-listed state-supported institutions within the service area of the community college shall be transferred to the local board.

31 (c) The local board of the community college shall be is responsible 32 for the administration and operation of all state-supported postsecondary 33 vocational-technical institutions located within its service area and 34 consolidated by this chapter.
