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19	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 15, Chapter 11, is amended to	o add an
20	additional subchapter to read as follows:	
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22	<u>Subchapter 10 — Arkansas Bikeways Commission</u>	
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24	15-11-1001. Creation — Powers and duties.	
25	(a) There is created the Arkansas Bikeways Commission.	
26	(b) The commission shall:	
27	(1) Actively promote the state as a destination for bi	cycling
28	tourism;	
29	(2) Actively promote the economic development benefits	<u>s of</u>
30	bicycling tourism in the state;	
31	(3) Make recommendations on the implementation of the	
32	Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan, including without limitation recommend	lations
33	<pre>concerning:</pre>	
34	(A) Bicycling safety;	
35	(B) Bicycling education; and	
36	(C) Developing the best practices and policy reg	<u>garding</u>

2	(4) Educate the community on the important benefits and
3	interests related to bicycling, including without limitation:
4	(A) Road and trail safety;
5	(B) Strengthening rural communities;
6	(C) Stewardship of the natural environment;
7	(D) Healthy lifestyles;
8	(E) Bicycle use for daily transportation; and
9	(F) Close-to-home recreation.
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11	<u> 15-11-1002. Arkansas Bikeways Commission — Members.</u>
12	(a) The Arkansas Bikeways Commission shall consist of:
13	(1) The following six (6) members to be appointed by the
14	Governor and confirmed by the Senate:
15	(A) One (1) member who is actively involved in the
16	hospitality industry;
17	(B) One (1) member who is a representative of the Arkansas
18	State Chamber of Commerce or other state or regional organization focused on
19	economic vitality;
20	(C) One (1) member who is an active newspaper, radio,
21	television, or other media employee;
22	(D) One (1) member who is an owner or employee of a
23	retailer, manufacturer, tour service, or repair service of bicycles;
24	(E) One (1) member who is a board member or employee of a
25	recognized state association promoting cycling interest; and
26	(F) One (1) member who is an interested community member
27	who is at least eighteen (18) years of age but less than twenty-five (25)
28	years of age at the time of his or her appointment to the commission;
29	(2) One (1) member appointed by the Chair of the House Committee
30	on Public Transportation;
31	(3) One (1) member appointed by the Chair of the Senate
32	Committee on Public Transportation, Technology, and Legislative Affairs;
33	(4) One (1) member appointed by the Chair of the House Committee
34	on City, County, and Local Affairs;
35	(5) One (1) member appointed by appointed by the Chair of the
36	Senate Committee on City, County, and Local Affairs;

1	(6) The Director of the Arkansas State Highway and
2	Transportation Department or his or her designee;
3	(7) The Director of the Arkansas Department of Parks and Tourism
4	or his or her designee; and
5	(8) The Director of the Arkansas Economic Development Commission
6	or his or her designee.
7	(b) Each member of the commission shall be a resident of this state.
8	(c) The members appointed to the commission shall be appointed for
9	terms of four (4) years.
10	(d)(1) A vacancy on the commission for any reason other than
11	expiration of the regular term of appointment shall be filled in the manner
12	of the original appointment.
13	(2)(A) The term of the member appointed under subdivision (d)(1)
14	of this section shall expire upon the regular term of the member he or she
15	replaced.
16	(B) The confirmation of a member appointed under
17	subdivision (d)(1) of this section by the Governor shall occur when the
18	Senate is next in session.
19	(e) Before performing duties on behalf of the commission, a member of
20	the commission shall take and file in the office of the Secretary of State an
21	oath to support the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of
22	the State of Arkansas and to faithfully perform the duties of the office upon
23	which he or she is about to enter.
24	(f) Members of the commission shall not receive compensation for their
25	services but may receive expense reimbursement and stipends in accordance
26	with § 25-16-901 et seq.
27	(g) The commission shall be staffed by the Department of Parks and
28	Tourism.
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30	<u>15-11-1003.</u> Organization — Meetings.
31	(a) The Arkansas Bikeways Commission shall select from its membership
32	a chair and a vice chair.
33	(b) The commission shall:
34	(1) Adopt rules for the conduct of its business; and
35	(2)(A) Keep a record of its transactions, findings, and
36	determinations.

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1	(B) The records of the commission shall be public.
2	(c)(l) Meetings of the commission shall be at the call of the chair of
3	the commission.
4	(2) Meetings of the commission may also be called in writing by
5	six (6) or more members.
6	(d) A quorum of the commission shall consist of not less than six (6)
7	members present at any regular or special meeting.
8	(e) An affirmative vote of six (6) members of the commission is
9	necessary for the disposition of any business.
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11	SECTION 2. Do Not Codify. Temporary Language. <u>The Governor shall</u>
12	call the first meeting of the Arkansas Bikeways Commission.
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
