20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-41-105 is amended to read as follows:

23 12-41-105. Commissions from prisoner telephone services and prisoner  
24 commissary services.

25 (a) Commissions derived from prisoner telephone services and prisoner  
26 commissary services provided in the various county and regional detention  
27 facilities in the state shall be deposited into the county treasury of the  
28 county in which the detention facility is located and shall be credited to  
29 the county sheriff's office fund.

30 (b)(1) Of the commissions deposited into the county sheriff's office  
31 fund in each county ~~pursuant to~~ under subsection (a) of this section, one  
32 hundred percent (100%) shall be credited to the county sheriff's office  
33 communications facility and equipment fund.

34 (2) Each county sheriff's office may allocate for the  
35 maintenance and operation of the county jail up to fifty percent (50%) of the  
36 commissions deposited into the county sheriff's office communications



1 facility and equipment fund.

2 (c) ~~The provisions of this~~ This section ~~do~~ does not apply to funds  
3 derived from prisoner telephone services or prisoner commissary services  
4 provided in Department of Correction facilities or Department of Community  
5 Correction facilities or in municipally owned detention facilities or in  
6 county detention facilities in counties with a population of one hundred  
7 seventy-five thousand (175,000) or more according to the latest federal  
8 decennial census.
