19	office;
20	(ix) The street name and block number, county, city,
21	and zip code where the sex offender is employed;
22	(x) Any institution of higher education in which the
23	sex offender is enrolled; and
24	(xi) The vehicle identification number and license
25	plate number of any vehicle the sex offender owns or operates \pm ; and
26	(xii) A physical description of the sex offender.
27	(B) If a registered sex offender was eighteen (18) years
28	of age or older at the time of the commission of the sex offense that
29	required registration under this subchapter and the victim of the sex offense
30	was fourteen (14) years of age or younger and the registered sex offender is
31	classified as a level 2 offender by the Community Notification Assessment,
32	the following information concerning the registered sex offender shall be
33	made public:
34	(i) The registered sex offender's complete name, as
35	well as any alias;
36	(ii) The registered sex offender's date of birth;

1	(iii) Any sex offense to which the registered sex
2	offender has pleaded guilty or nolo contendere or of which the registered sex
3	offender has been found guilty by a court of competent jurisdiction;
4	(iv) The street name and block number, county, city,
5	and zip code where the registered sex offender resides;
6	(v) The registered sex offender's race and gender;
7	(vi) The date of the last address verification of
8	the registered sex offender provided to the center;
9	(vii) The most recent photograph of the registered
10	sex offender that has been submitted to the center;
11	(viii) The registered sex offender's parole or
12	probation office;
13	(ix) The street name and block number, county, city,
14	and zip code where the sex offender is employed;
15	(x) Any institution of higher education in which the
16	sex offender is enrolled; and
17	(xi) The vehicle identification number and license
18	plate number of any vehicle the sex offender owns or operates.
19	(B) Information regarding a sex offender who was
20	adjudicated as a juvenile offender is not required to be posted on the
21	Internet home page unless the juvenile is mandated to register by law or
22	unless the juvenile division of court requires that relevant information to
23	be placed on the Internet home page.
24	(C) The center shall prepare and place the information
25	described in subdivisions (j)(l)(A) and (B) of this section on the Internet
26	home page of the State of Arkansas.
27	(2) The center may promulgate any rules necessary to implement
28	and administer this subsection.

30	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 12-12-919(a), concerning the termination of
31	a registered sex offender's obligation to register, is amended to read as
32	follows:
33	(a) Lifetime registration is required for a sex offender who:
34	(1) Was found to have committed an aggravated sex offense;
35	(2) Was determined by the court to be or assessed as a Level 4
36	sexually dangerous person; or

1	(3) Has pleaded guilty or nolo contendere to or been found guilty
2	of a second or subsequent sex offense under a separate case number, not
3	multiple counts on the same charge+; or
4	(4) Was convicted of any of the following offenses on or after
5	the effective date of this act:
6	(A) Rape, § 5-14-103;
7	(B) Sexual assault in the first degree, § 5-14-124;
8	(C) Sexual assault in the second degree, § 5-14-125, if
9	the victim was under thirteen (13) years of age;
10	(D) Sexual assault in the third degree, § 5-14-126, if the
11	victim was under sixteen (16) years of age;
12	(E) Kidnapping, $\S 5-11-102(a)(5)$, if the victim was a
13	minor and the sex offender was not the parent of the minor; or
14	(F) Incest, § 5-26-202.
