22	SECTION 1. APPR	OPRIATION - CRIMINAL JUSTICE INSTIT	UTE. There is hereby
23	appropriated, to the University of Arkansas, to be payable from the

29	SECTION 2. COMP	LIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disburseme	nt of funds
30	authorized by this ac	t shall be limited to the appropria	tion for such agency
31	and funds made availa	ble by law for the support of such	appropriations; and
32	the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and		
33	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary		
34	Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures		
35	Restrictions Act, or	their successors, and other fiscal	control laws of this
36	State, where applicab	le, and regulations promulgated by	the Department of

1	Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied		
2	with in disbursement of said funds.

4	SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General		
5	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations		
6	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for		
7	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive		
8	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget		
9	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, o		
10	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislativ		
11	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.		
12			
13	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General		
14	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the		
15	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the		
16	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of		
17	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that is		
18	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the		
19	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm		
20	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental		
21	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act		
22	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health		
23	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
