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SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND 9 10 TRANSFER. To provide funding for the appropriations authorized herein, the 11 Director of the Assessment Coordination Department of the State of Arkansas 12 shall certify monthly to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the amount of 13 funding needed each month to pay counties and professional reappraisal 14 companies for the reappraisal of real property as required by law. MAXIMUM ANNUAL FUNDING FOR REAPPRAISALS/REVIEWS. Whether a county's reappraisal of 28 29 real property is simply a review of existing data, or a more extensive reappraisal where every improvement is measured, funding to any county, 30 provided through the Assessment Coordination Department, will be for the 31 actual appraisal cost, up to a maximum of seven dollars per parcel, per year. 32 Counties must use other taxing unit sources of revenue to provide for the 33 34 cost of real property reappraisals if the cost to complete the reappraisal

35 exceeds seven dollars per parcel.

1 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
2 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

5 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
6 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015. /s/Joint Budget Committee
