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23	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION -	HEMINGWAY-PFEIFFER MUSE	UM AND EDUCATIONAL
24	CENTER. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State University, to		
25	be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund		
26	accounts, the following:		
27	(A) for major maintenance,	construction, operating	expenses, security
28	equipment, repairs, and equipment	for the Hemingway-Pfei	ffer Museum and
29	Educational Center, in a sum not	to exceed	\$500,000.

31	SECTION 2. DISBURSEMENT CON	TROLS. (A) No contract	may be awarded nor
32	obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects		
33	described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available		
34	therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and		
35	agencies listed herein shall have	the authority to accep	t and use grants and
36	donations including Federal funds	, and to use its unobli	gated cash income or

- 1 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
- 2 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
- enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds 3
- 4 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
- 5 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
- 6 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.
- 7 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
- 8 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
- 9 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
- and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, 10

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

19 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

21 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the

26 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of

27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 28

effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm 29

30 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental

programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 31

32 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

33 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.

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
