## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES  
9 AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS  
10 - CRIMINAL JUSTICE INSTITUTE - SCHOOL, CAMPUS, AND  
11 CHILD SAFETY INITIATIVE AND ACTIVE SHOOTER/SAFE  
12 SCHOOLS INITIATIVE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE  
13 30, 2016; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

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16 AN ACT FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS -  
17 CRIMINAL JUSTICE INSTITUTE - SCHOOL,  
18 CAMPUS, AND CHILD SAFETY INITIATIVE AND  
19 ACTIVE SHOOTER/SAFE SCHOOLS INITIATIVE  
20 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2015-2016 FISCAL  
21 YEAR.  
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25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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27 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - CRIMINAL JUSTICE INSTITUTE - SCHOOL, CAMPUS,  
28 AND CHILD SAFETY INITIATIVE & ACTIVE SHOOTER/SAFE SCHOOLS INITIATIVE. There  
29 is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas, to be payable from the  
30 University of Arkansas Fund, for personal services and operating expenses for  
31 education and training of school, law enforcement, judicial, medical, higher  
32 education, and other personnel and professionals, to strengthen public school  
33 and campus safety and identify and protect drug-affected children, of the  
34 University of Arkansas - Criminal Justice Institute for the fiscal year  
35 ending June 30, 2016, the following:

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16       SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 17 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 18 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
 19 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 20 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures  
 22 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
 23 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
 24 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
 25 with in disbursement of said funds.

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27       SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
 28 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
 29 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
 30 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
 31 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
 32 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
 33 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
 34 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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36       SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

1 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
2 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
3 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of  
4 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
5 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
6 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm  
7 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
8 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
9 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
10 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.

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
