4	SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
5	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. USE OF
6	FUNDS. The Arkansas Highway and Transportation Department shall use the funds
7	appropriated in Section 1 of this Act exclusively to provide for the
8	maintenance and repair of roads and bridges damaged by trucks and other heavy
9	equipment used for the purposes of extracting natural gas or other drilling
10	operations, by granting of funds to counties or cities. These funds shall not
11	be used for regular road or bridge maintenance or repair nor is there any
12	requirement of the Arkansas Highway and Transportation Department to ensure
13	that funds are equally distributed by city, county, district, or any other
14	geographical or political subdivision of this state.
15	The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015
16	through June 30, 2016.
17	
18	SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
19	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MAXIMUM
20	FUNDING ALLOCATION. In no event shall the funding for appropriations made in
21	any fiscal year for the Arkansas Highway and Transportation Department for
22	road and bridge repair, maintenance, and grants exceed the maximum amount of
23	general revenue allocated and distributed under Arkansas Code Annotated 26-
24	58-124 (c)(1) from the previous fiscal year, less six hundred seventy five
25	thousand dollars (\$675,000).
26	The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015
27	through June 30, 2016.
28	
29	SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
30	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
31	FORWARD OF FUNDS. Any unexpended balance of funds remaining in the
32	Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account as allocated for the line item
33	appropriation Road and Bridge Repair, Maintenance, and Grants to Political
34	Subdivisions made in this Act which remains at the end of a fiscal year shall
35	be carried forward into the next fiscal year and made available for the same
36	purposes.

- 1 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein, may
- 2 be carried forward under the following conditions:
- 3 (1) Prior to June 30, -2015 2016 the Agency shall by written statement set
- 4 forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the
- 5 Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;
- 6 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall
- 7 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward by the
- 8 September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting
- 9 which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or
- 10 Institution and the amount of funding carried forward, the program name or
- line item, the funding source and a copy of the written request set forth in
- 12 (1) above;
- 13 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
- 14 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
- 15 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
- 16 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
- 17 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
- days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
- 19 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
- 20 Committee; and
- 21 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
- 22 all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals and/or a
- 23 statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.

- 27 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
- 28 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
- 29 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
- 30 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 33 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 34 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 35 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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1	SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
2	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
3	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
4	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
5	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
6	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
7	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
8	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
9	
10	SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
11	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
12	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
13	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of
14	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
15	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
16	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm
17	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
18	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
19	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
20	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
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
