18	THE DISTRIBUTION OF THE NINETIETH SESSION
19	PROJECTS ACCOUNT OF THE GENERAL
20	IMPROVEMENT FUND TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL
21	FUNDS FOR THE STATE BUDGET.
22	
23	
24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
25	
26	SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the "General Improvement
27	Distribution Act of 2015".
28	
29	SECTION 2. There is hereby created and established on the books of the
30	Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the State Treasurer and the State Auditor,
31	the "90th Session Projects Account" within the "General Improvement Fund",
32	into which shall be transferred and credited the respective monies as
33	hereinafter provided in this Act, to be used for providing financing, in the
34	manner set forth herein, for the various projects and purposes enumerated in
35	this Act to be financed from said account.

36 Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, or as soon thereafter

as is practical, the State Treasurer shall transfer and credit to the "90th
 Session Projects Account" of the "General Improvement Fund", upon
 certification of the amounts thereof by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
 State, the following:

5 (a) all unobligated and unallocated monies remaining in the "General 6 Improvement Fund" on June 30, 2015 which are not required to finance projects 7 to be financed therefrom pursuant to appropriations enacted by the 89th 8 General Assembly, or which have not been reappropriated or reallocated for 9 financing from the "General Improvement Fund" by the 90th General Assembly;

10 (b)(1) any unobligated or unallocated funds remaining on July 2, 2015, 11 including all General Revenue Funds recovered from remaining fund balances in 12 the "General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund" from monies accruing thereto 13 during the 2013-2015 fiscal biennium which are not required to finance 14 enactments of the 90th General Assembly that do not expire on June 30, <u>2015</u>,

(2) All General Revenue Funds recovered from remaining fund balances in
 the "General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund" from monies accruing thereto
 during the 2015-2016 fiscal year which are not required to finance enactments
 of the 90th General Assembly that do not expire on June 30, 2016.

(c) interest earned on State Treasury fund balances as provided in
this subsection. For the period commencing on July 1, 2015, and ending June
30, 2017, the State Treasurer shall, after complying with provisions of

(1) Arkansas Code 27-70-204 for distributing interest income
earned from investment of average daily balances of the "State Highway and
Transportation Department Fund",

(2) Arkansas Code 15-41-110 for distributing interest earned from
investment of average daily balances of the "Game Protection Fund", and

27 (3) Arkansas Code 20-78-504 for the next one hundred thousand 28 dollars (\$100,000) of interest income received each fiscal year by the State 29 Treasurer for the "Arkansas Child Care Facilities Loan Guarantee Trust Fund", 30 credit to the "Budget Stabilization Trust Fund" or its successor fund, fifty 31 percent (50%) of the interest income received and credited to the "Securities 32 Reserve Fund", and credit to the "90th Session Projects Account" fifty percent (50%) of the interest income received and credited to the "Securities 33 34 Reserve Fund" as certified by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to 35 provide financing to the "90th Session Projects Account", until there has 36 been credited an amount, which when added to the other funds available for

3	(d) Those special revenues credited to the General Improvement Fund
4	from estate taxes as set out in Arkansas Code 19-6-301(171).
5	(e) Any available balance remaining in the 89th Session Projects
6	Account of the General Improvement Fund from funds set aside for subsections
7	(a)(2) and (a)(3) of Section 3 of Act 1518 and Act 1519 of 2013 and any funds
8	made available for a Rainy Day Set-Aside as authorized in subsection (a)(ii)
9	of Section 10 of SB689 and HB1548 of 2015 to Amend the Revenue Stabilization
10	Law are to be made available and distributed as authorized in Section 3
11	subsection (a)(11) herein; and
12	(f) Any funds provided by the Arkansas Attorney General from the
13	Attorney General Consumer Education and Enforcement Account, received by the
14	State of Arkansas through Settlement agreements or as designated by court
15	<u>order.</u>
16	
17	SECTION 3. Of those moneys accruing to the 90th Session Projects
18	Account of the General Improvement Fund as set out in Section 2 of this Act,
19	the State Treasurer shall first set-aside two hundred three million, three
20	hundred ninety-eight thousand, ten dollars (\$203,398,010), and any previous
21	set-aside remaining balance as made available by subsection (e) of Section 2
22	of this Act for the set-asides enumerated in subsection (a) of Section 3 of
23	this Act. Such funds set-aside as enumerated in Section 3 subsections (a)(1)
24	through (a)(10) shall be fully funded by June 30, 2017. The Shared Mandatory
25	Obligations Set-Asides enumerated in Section 3 subsections (a)(1) through
26	(a)(10) shall be distributed from time to time in amounts as determined by
27	the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. If it is determined by the Chief
28	Fiscal Officer of the State that funding made available for Section 3
29	subsections (a)(4) and (a)(7) through (a)(10) is not required at the full
30	amount authorized by this Act, then any portion of those funds may be
31	transferred to the Rainy Day Set-Aside established by Section 3 subsection
32	(a)(11) of this Act. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall notify the
33	Arkansas Legislative Council or the Joint Budget Committee of the release of
34	funds for projects enumerated in Section 3 subsections (a), (b)(3) and (d)
35	and any funds transferred to Section 3 subsection (a)(11) at the same time
36	that the Department of Finance and Administration is notified.

17	transfers, from time to time, for projects in the Executive Discretionary
18	Division authorized in subsection (d) of Section 3 of this Act, upon approval
19	by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.
20	
21	(b)(1)Then the Treasurer of State shall distribute twenty million
22	dollars (\$20,000,000) to the Legislative Division as set out in subsection
23	(c) of this Act, and twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000) to the Executive
24	Discretionary Division as set out in subsection (d) of this Act. Funds made
25	available to the Executive Discretionary Division may be used for any project
26	or portion thereof enumerated within the Executive Discretionary Division but
27	not to exceed the amount set out in subsection (d) for the project. The Chief
28	Fiscal Officer of the State shall notify the Arkansas Legislative Council or
29	Joint Budget Committee of the Governor's released funds for projects at the
30	same time that the Department of Finance and Administration is notified. The
31	Legislative Division funds shall be used to provide funds to each project
32	enumerated in subsection (c) of this section in proportion that each

(a) Expenditure of the funds 2 authorized by the Ninetieth General Assembly in either the regular, fiscal or extraordinary session from the 90th Session Projects Account shall be made 3 4 only upon documentation to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, in such 5 form as deemed necessary, that all criteria or pre-conditions established in 6 the appropriation act have been met or in the case of state agencies, and 7 that a Method of Finance has been filed with the Office of Accounting in the 8 Department of Finance and Administration, if required.

9 (b) Any matching funds as may be provided in law shall be certified to 10 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State prior to the commencement of the 11 project.

(c) Any recipient of the funds appropriated herein:(1) may be required to file a compliance audit and

(2) is also subject to an audit by the Division of Legislative
Audit in order to determine that the use of the funds was in compliance with
the intent and appropriated purposes of the General Assembly.

18 SECTION 7. (a) Any enactment of the 90th General Assembly in either 19 regular, fiscal or extraordinary session appropriating, transferring or 20 allocating funds to be payable from the "General Improvement Fund", for which 21 a specific allocation of funds is specifically authorized in this Act, shall 22 be deemed to be payable from the "90th Session Projects Account" within the 23 "General Improvement Fund" unless a specific intent is otherwise provided by 24 law.

(b) Any enactment of the 90th General Assembly, meeting in either Regular, Fiscal or Extraordinary Session, appropriating, allocating or transferring funds payable from the General Improvement Fund which is not enumerated in this Act shall not be financed from monies accruing to the 90th Session Projects Account, unless otherwise provided by law and funds are specifically transferred from the 89th Session Projects Account to the 90th Session Projects Account to fund the appropriation for the project.

32 (c) Monies reappropriated by the 90th General Assembly for projects 33 for which appropriations were made by the 89th General Assembly, which are 34 not enumerated in this Act and which are made payable from the "General 35 Improvement Fund", shall be payable from the "89th Session Projects Account" 36 of the "General Improvement Fund" and allowances shall be made therefore in

arriving at the uncommitted and unobligated balance of monies in the "General
 Improvement Fund" before making transfers therefrom to the "90th Session
 Projects Account", as authorized by this Act.

4

5 SECTION 8. Distribution of funds for constructing and equipping the 6 radiation therapy institutes specified herein, shall be contingent upon the 7 provision of matching funds, including those monies previously raised but not 8 previously used to match state funds, on a dollar by dollar basis on behalf 9 of each such radiation therapy institute.

10

11 SECTION 9. DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION DISBURSING 12 OFFICER. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may distribute funds to the 13 projects in the Legislative Division enumerated under Department of Finance 14 and Administration - Disbursing Officer on a basis other than monthly after 15 prior review of the proposed calendar for disbursements by the Legislative 16 Council.

17

18 SECTION 10. This Act shall not be incorporated into the Arkansas Code 19 nor published separately as Special, Local and Temporary law. However, 20 individual sections in this Act may amend Arkansas Code if specifically 21 stated to do so.

SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE
 ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 <u>DUPLICATE ACTS If HB1547 and SB691 of 2015 of the 2015 Regular Session of the</u>
 90th General Assembly are both enacted and adopted by the 90th General
 <u>Assembly in identical form, then the last Act passed or latest expression</u>
 shall supersede the other.

30 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 31 General Assembly that it has considered and enacted appropriations for 32 construction projects and other programs to be financed from the accumulated 33 balances and reserve funds available in the State Treasury; that the total of 34 the enacted appropriations exceed the estimated available funding available 35 for such projects and that the immediate passage of this Act is necessary to 36 establish a method of providing for the orderly financing and a system of

1	priority for the financing of such projects. Therefore, an emergency is
2	declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the
3	preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on
4	July 1, 2015.
