23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-60-205 is amended to read as follows:  
26 6-60-205. In-state tuition for veterans and military personnel and  
27 dependents.

28 Regardless of residence, a state-supported institution of higher  
29 education, trade schools, or vocational schools shall classify a student as  
30 in-state, in-county, in-district, local, or resident for the purpose of  
31 tuition and fees applicable for all programs of study, including distance  
32 learning programs, if the student is a:

33 (1) Veteran;

34 (2) Dependent of a veteran dependents;

35 (3) ~~If a member~~ Member of the armed forces ~~is~~ stationed in the  
36 State of Arkansas under military orders, ~~he or she and his or her~~



1 ~~unemancipated dependents shall be entitled to classification as "in-state"~~  
2 ~~for the purpose of paying fees at state-supported colleges and universities;~~

4 (4) Dependent of a member of the armed forces.
