
23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-60-205 is amended to read as follows:

26 6-60-205. In-state tuition for veterans and military personnel and
27 dependents.

28 Regardless of residence, a state-supported institution of higher
29 education, trade schools, or vocational schools shall classify a student as
30 in-state, in-county, in-district, local, or resident for the purpose of
31 tuition and fees applicable for all programs of study, including distance
32 learning programs, if the student is a:

33 (1) Veteran who was discharged or released from a period of not
34 less than ninety (90) days of active duty in the military, naval, or air
35 service within three (3) years before the date of enrollment in a program of
36 study;

(2) Dependent of a veteran under subdivision (1) of this section;

~~(3) -If a member Member of the armed forces is stationed in the State of Arkansas under military orders, he or she and his or her unemancipated dependents shall be entitled to classification as "in-state" for the purpose of paying fees at state supported colleges and universities;~~
or

(4) Spouse of a member of the armed forces.
