7	certain events — Sale in excess of regular price.	
8	(a)(1) It is unlawful for any person, corporation, firm, or	
9	partnership to sell resell or offer for sale any resale a ticket to:	
10	(A) A high school or college athletic event or to an	
11	athletic or other event held for the benefit of charity at a greater price	
12	than that printed on the ticket; or	
13	(B) Any music entertainment event at a greater price than	
14	that printed on the ticket or the box office sale price plus any reasonable	
15	charge for handling or credit card use, whichever is the greater. an event	
16	for a price higher than the greater of either:	
17	(A) The price originally charged for the ticket by the	
18	venue or entity hosting the event or the venue or entity's authorized agent	
19	plus a reasonable charge for handling or credit card use; or	
20	(B) The price printed on the ticket.	
21	(2) This subsection $\frac{1}{2}$ does not apply to an institution of	
22	higher education that receives funds per ticket above the face value of that	
23	the ticket.	
24	(b)(l) Any person, corporation, firm, or partnership violating any	
25	provision of this section is guilty of a violation and upon conviction shall	
26	be fined in any sum not less than twenty-five dollars ($\$25.00$) nor more than	
27	five hundred dollars (\$500).	
28	(2) Every sale or offer for sale is a separate offense.	
29	(c) As used in this section, "event" means a live entertainment event,	
30	athletic event, sporting event, theater performance, musical performance, or	
31	an event held for the benefit of charity.	
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
