20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
23 Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Office for the 2015-2016 fiscal year,
24 the following maximum number of regular employees.

 21 appropriated, to the Arkansas Geographic *Information Systems* Office, to be
 22 payable from the Geographic Information Systems Fund, to carry out the
 23 duties, responsibilities and authority of the Arkansas State Land Information
 24 Board as described by Arkansas Code 15-21-504; to create, operate and
 25 maintain Geostor, the Arkansas Spatial Data Infrastructure and to create,
 26 update, maintain and disseminate framework spatial data as defined by
 27 Arkansas Code 15-21-502 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the
 28 following:

 34 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - PARCEL MAPPING GRANT. There is hereby
 35 appropriated, to the Arkansas Geographic *Information Systems* Office, to be
 36 payable from the Geographic Information Systems Fund, for expenses of

1 implementing and administering the Statewide Mapping Grant Program by the
 2 Arkansas Geographic *Information Systems* Office for the fiscal year ending
 3 June 30, 2016, the following:

9 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - MOVING AHEAD FOR PROGRESS - 21ST CENTURY.

10 There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Geographic *Information Systems*
 11 Office, to be payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief
 12 Fiscal Officer of the State, for operating expenses for the implementation of
 13 a referencing system including road class, road design, and surface type of
 14 the Arkansas Geographic *Information Systems* Office for the fiscal year ending
 15 June 30, 2016, the following:

27 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL, OR TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
 29 OF CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of funds remaining on June 30 of
 30 each fiscal year in the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account for the Arkansas
 31 Geographic Information Office, shall be transferred to the Geographic
 32 Information Systems Fund to be used for operating and maintaining the
 33 Arkansas Spatial Data Infrastructure, creating, updating, maintaining and
 34 disseminating framework spatial data as defined by Arkansas Code §15-21-502.
 35 (1) Prior to June 30, 2016 the Agency shall by written statement set forth
 36 its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the Department of

1 Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

2 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall
3 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward by the
4 September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting
5 which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or
6 Institution and the amount of the funding carried forward, the program name
7 or line item, the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the
8 written request set forth in (1) above;

9 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
10 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
11 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
12 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
13 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
14 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
15 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
16 Committee; and

17 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
18 all information obtained in item (3) above in the biennial budget manuals
19 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or
20 Institution.

21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
22 2015 through June 30, 2016.

23
24 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
25 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
26 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
27 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
28 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
29 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
30 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
31 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
32 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

33
34 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
35 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
36 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for

1 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
2 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
3 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
4 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
5 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
6

7 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
8 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
9 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
10 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of
11 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
12 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
13 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm
14 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
15 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
16 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
17 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
