(c) Abuse of public trust is a: (1) Class B felony if the value of the benefit is twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) or more; (2) Class C felony if the value of the benefit is five thousand dollars (\$5,000) or more but less than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000); or (3) Class D felony if the value of the benefit is less than five thousand dollars (\$5,000).
