20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 25-10-128 is amended to read as follows:

24	(a) There is created in the Department of Human Services a Division	of
25	Community Service and Nonprofit Support.	
26	(b)(1) Administrative assistance to coordinate the activities of the	e
27	division shall be given by a Deputy Director for Community Service and	
28	Nonprofit Support who will shall devote full time to the duties of the off	
29	of deputy director and assume the responsibility for carrying out the duti	es
30	prescribed by this section.	
31	(2) The deputy director shall employ any employees who are	
32	necessary to carry out the goals of the office of deputy director, subject	to
33	appropriation by the General Assembly.

- 3 (2) Assist in specific projects involving volunteers to meet 4 community needs;
- 5 (3) Provide greater public awareness and recognition of 6 volunteer efforts; and
- 7 (4) Assist in devising training programs for use by community
 8 organizations that have programs to assist welfare recipients of public
 9 assistance and to assist other divisions of the department in devising and
 10 administering programs to match those current and past welfare recipients of
 11 public assistance with any community organizations that desire to assist
 12 them.
- 13 (d)(1) The program and staff of the Division of Community Service and
 14 Nonprofit Support division will shall be assisted by an advisory council
 15 commission on national service and volunteerism.
- 16 <u>(2)</u> It <u>will shall</u> be the responsibility of <u>this council the</u>
 17 <u>commission</u> to assist the staff in setting goals, establishing priority
 18 activities, performing an advocacy role, and assisting in funding and
 19 resource development and publicity and recognition and awards programs.
- 20 <u>(3)(A)</u> Council Commission members shall be appointed by the 21 Governor from existing state, local, and private agencies that operate 22 volunteer programs and shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor.
- 23 (B)(i) Members of the commission shall be appointed by the 24 Governor on a bipartisan basis.
- 25 (ii) It shall consist of an odd number of members
 26 with no fewer than fifteen (15) and no more than twenty-five (25) voting
 27 members.
- 28 <u>(iii) Not more than fifty percent (50%) of the</u>
 29 <u>voting members of the commission plus one (1) voting member may be from the</u>
 30 <u>same political party.</u>
- 31 (iv) To the extent possible, it shall be balanced
 32 according to race, ethnicity, age, disability, and gender characteristics.
 33 (C) The commission shall include the following nine (9)
 34 voting members:
- (i) An individual with expertise in the educational,
 training, and developmental needs of youth, particularly disadvantaged youth;

1	(ii) An individual with experience in promoting the
2	involvement of older adults in service and volunteering;
3	(iii) A representative of community-based agencies
4	or community-based organizations within the state;
5	(iv) A representative of the state educational
6	agency;
7	(v) A representative of local governments in the
8	state;
9	(vi) A representative of local labor organizations
10	in the state;
11	(vii) A representative of business and industry in
12	Arkansas;
13	(viii) An individual between the ages of sixteen
14	(16) and twenty-five (25) who is a participant or supervisor in a volunteer
15	or service program; and
16	(ix) A representative of a National Service Program
17	as described in the National and Community Services Trust Act of 1993, Pub.
18	<u>L. No. 103-82.</u>
19	(D) The terms of office shall be staggered between one (1)
20	and five (5) years and shall be determined by lot at the commission's initial
21	meeting.
