6	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
7	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that athletics play a crucial role
8	in the school experience for many students; that opportunities for athletic
9	participation can be limited to students depending on the school the student
10	attends; and that this act is immediately necessary to ensure that the AAA
11	can prepare rules and schedules for the 2015-2016 school year. Therefore, an
12	emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for
13	the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become
14	effective on:
15	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
16	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
17	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
18	bill; or
19	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
20	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
