SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 13 14 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 15 OF FUNDS FOR THE JUVENILE OMBUDSMAN PROGRAM. The Department of Human 16 Services shall provide funding in an amount not to exceed \$240,000 for the 17 fiscal year ending June 30, 2015 2016 for the Juvenile Ombudsman Program 18 described in ACA 16-87-216. 27 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 29 OF FUNDS FOR LOCAL JUVENILE DETENTION FACILITIES. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer funds in an amount of \$400,000 for the fiscal 30 31 year ending June 30, 2015 2016 from the Department of Human Services - Youth Services Fund Account to the Juvenile Detention Facilities Operating Fund to 32 33 fund the appropriation to the Department of Finance and Administration -34 Disbursing Officer for grants for operating expenses of local juvenile 35 detention facilities.

8 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. YOUTH 9 10 SERVICES - TIMBER SALES PROCEEDS - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND EQUIPMENT. The 11 Division of Youth Services is authorized to use the administrative operating 12 account for capital improvements to the physical plant and for the purchase 13 of capital equipment by the Mansfield Youth Services Facility operated by the 14 Department of Human Services, Division of Youth Services. The funds shall be 15 held by the Department of Human Services, Division of Youth Services from the 16 proceeds of the sale of timber that may be harvested from land owned by the 17 Division of Youth Services. All funds deposited and all expenses shall be 18 tracked separately. The harvesting of timber is specifically authorized to 19 provide funds to finance capital improvements to the physical plant and for 20 the purchase of major capital equipment by the Mansfield Facility from which 21 the timber is sold.

The Division of Youth Services shall report all income derived from the sale of timber to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the Arkansas Legislative Council. Any contracts initiated for the harvesting and sale of timber shall be submitted to the Review Subcommittee of the Arkansas Legislative Council for prior review. All expenditures of funds derived from the sale of timber will be expended in accordance with relevant state purchasing laws.

32 SECTION *12*. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REGULAR 34 SALARIES - CONTINGENT EDUCATIONAL SERVICES POSITIONS. If it has been 35 determined by the Director of the Department of Human Services that the 36 Division of Youth Services cannot continue a contract with a private provider

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1 for educational services and deems it necessary to utilize Division staff to 2 provide the required educational services, the Division is authorized, to seek the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the Governor and 3 4 the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, to utilize the 5 contingent educational services positions contained in this Act and to make 6 the appropriate transfers from the Residential Services Appropriation line 7 item contained in this Act to Regular Salaries, Personal Services Matching, 8 and various Maintenance and General Operations classifications.

9 There is hereby established for the Division of Youth Services -10 Contingent Educational Services Positions for the 2014-2015 2015-2016 fiscal 11 year, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall 12 be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation 13 Act (Arkansas Code 21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws 14 amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific 15 maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the 16 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons 17 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions 18 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code 21-5-19 101), or its successor.

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SECTION 13. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 2 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 3 4 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 5 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 6 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 7 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 8 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 9 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 10 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

12 SECTION 14. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 13 14 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 15 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 16 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 17 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 18 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 19 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 20

21 SECTION 15. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 22 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 23 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of 24 25 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 26 27 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 28 29 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 30 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015. 31 32 33 /s/Joint Budget Committee 34
