20	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETIETH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE
21	OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS
22	ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:
23	
24	THAT the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
25	the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
26	for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives
27	and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election,
28	adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of
29	the State of Arkansas, to wit:
30	
31	SECTION 1. Arkansas Constitution Amendment 31, Section 1 is amended to
32	read as follows:
33	§ 1. Election on question — Tax levy.
34	After consent of the majority of those voting on the question at any
35	general or special election in cities of the first or second class, the
36	cities may annually thereafter, levy a tax on the assessed value of real and

1	personal property, not to exceed $\frac{1}{1}$ four $\frac{1}{4}$ mills on the dollar, from which
2	there shall be created a Fund to pay Retirement Salaries and pensions to
3	policemen and firemen theretofore or thereafter earned, and pensions to the
4	widows and minor children of such, as may be provided by law. The annual
5	levy for the Policeman's Retirement Salary and Pension Fund shall not exceed
6	$\frac{1}{2}$ on the dollar, and the annual levy for the Fireman's
7	Retirement Salary and Pension Funds, shall not exceed one mill two (2) mills
8	on the dollar. The manner of such levy of the tax, and the eligibility for
9	the retirement salaries and pensions, the several amounts thereof and when
10	payable, shall be such as may be provided by law.
11	
12	SECTION 2. BALLOT TITLE AND POPULAR NAME. When this proposed
13	amendment is submitted to the electors of this state on the general election
14	<pre>ballot:</pre>
15	(1) The title of this Joint Resolution shall be the ballot
16	title; and
17	(2) The popular name shall be "An Amendment to the Arkansas
18	Constitution Concerning Retirement Salary and Pension Funds for Municipal
19	Police Officers and Municipal Firefighters".
