24	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETIETH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE
25	OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS
26	ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:
27	
28	That the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
29	the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
30	for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives
31	and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
32	adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of
33	the State of Arkansas, to wit:

35	SECTION 1. The purpose of this resolution is to propose an amendment
36	to the Arkansas Constitution to encourage job creation, job expansion, and

1	economic development, including without limitation allowing public entities
2	to engage in job creation and job expansion activities, allowing public
3	entities to finance economic development activities with financial
4	incentives, and allowing public entities to finance growing state and local
5	economies with financial incentives to achieve job creation, job expansion,
6	and other activities.
