17	in Arkadelphia, Arkansas, to parents Claudius William and Lillian Scott
18	Dwiggins of Amity, Arkansas; and
19	
20	WHEREAS, Senator Dwiggins passed away on May 24, 2015, at seventy-six
21	(76) years of age in Rochester, Minnesota; and
22	
23	WHEREAS, Senator Dwiggins was passionate about public service and
24	served in the Arkansas State Senate from 1980 to 1986, and in 1981 he was
25	named Arkansas Outstanding Freshman Legislator; and
26	
27	WHEREAS, as an Arkansas State Senator, Senator Dwiggins served on
28	numerous committees, including Senate Legislative Affairs and Aging, Senate
29	Revenue and Taxation, Public Transportation, Legislative Joint Audit, and
30	Arkansas Southeast and Southwest Legislative Delegation, and he was the Vice-
31	Chairman of the Senate Education Committee; and

33	WHEREAS, Senator Dwiggins also served as an alternate member of the
34	Agriculture and Rural Development Committee of the Southern States
35	Legislative Conference and he was selected by the Legislative Council as
36	council representative for the fourth Congressional District; and

2	WHEREAS, Senator Dwiggins attended Amity High School and then the
3	University of Arkansas where he studied mechanical engineering; and
4	
5	WHEREAS, Senator Dwiggins was also passionate about farming as a third-
6	generation peach farmer on land that was homesteaded in the late 1800s; and
7	
8	WHEREAS, Senator Dwiggins was a member of the Arkansas Air National
9	Guard from $1960$ to $1966$ , and he was an inventor who earned a patent from the
10	United States Patent and Trademark Office; and
11	
12	WHEREAS, Senator Dwiggins served on the Amity School Board and served
13	as a board member of South Central Arkansas Electric Cooperative for three
14	(3) terms; and
15	
16	WHEREAS, Senator Dwiggins is remembered for his dedication to family,
17	farming, and public service; and
18	
19	WHEREAS, Senator Dwiggins is survived by his wife, Rebecca Riggle
20	Dwiggins; sons, Barry Dwiggins and Chris Dwiggins; granddaughters, Haylea and
21	Hannah Dwiggins; and brothers, Dr. Claudius William Dwiggins, Jr. of
22	Bartlesville, Oklahoma, and David Dwiggins of Arkadelphia, Arkansas,
