SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 29 30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA 31 HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Workforce Services 32 for the 2015-2016 2016-2017 fiscal year, the following maximum number of 33 part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from 34 funds appropriated herein for such purposes: three hundred eighty (380) 35 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed 36 those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its

- successor, for the appropriate classification. Any of these positions utilized in a manner which are funded by federal sources are specifically exempt from limitation of hours, either by Act or Regulation.
- 4 In order to comply with the timeliness requirements set forth by the 5 Social Security Act, the Chairman of the Board of Review is authorized to 6 utilize part-time or temporary employees from the pool of positions provided 7 to the Department of Workforce Services in any occurrence where the number of 8 appeals to the Board of Review or Appeal Tribunal increases above a level 9 that can be resolved by the permanent staff in a timely manner. The 10 Department of Workforce services will determine the appropriate funding 11 source within the Department for said positions.
- 12 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2015}{2016}$ through June 30, $\frac{2016}{2017}$.

15 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. "REED"

CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. "REED ACT FUNDS". Funds received by the State may be used as specified in 903 of the Social Security Act, for the purpose of construction and improvement of buildings, rent/lease costs, acquisition of land, the payment of salaries and related benefits of central and local office staff, maintenance and operation of central and local offices, payment of unemployment insurance benefits, or as otherwise prescribed in Section 903 of the Social Security Act, as amended.

The amount obligated pursuant to this Act shall not exceed the amount by which (a) the aggregate of the amounts transferred to the account of this State pursuant to Section 903 of the Social Security Act exceeds (b) the aggregate of the amounts used by this State and charged against the amounts transferred to the account of this State.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2015}{30}$ 30 $\frac{2016}{30}$ through June 30, $\frac{2016}{30}$.

SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

ADDITIONAL POSITIONS. The Director of the Department of Workforce Services, after receiving the approval of the Office of Personnel Management, and after

seeking the prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, shall have the

- 1 authority to establish such new or additional full time positions as may
- 2 become necessary to carry out the objectives of the program and/or to meet
- 3 Federal requirements of new and/or expanded programs where such needs are
- 4 financed by federal funds; provided that not more than two hundred persons
- 5 may be employed in addition to those authorized in the salary schedule and
- 6 that the rate of pay shall not exceed those set out in the salary schedule
- 7 for comparable positions as authorized under the provisions of Section 1 of
- 8 this Act.
- 9 If the agency requests continuation of a "Growth Pool" position(s) as
- 10 established herein, the position(s) must be requested as a new position(s) in
- 11 the agency's budget request.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015
- 13 2016 through June 30, 2016 2017.

- 15 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
- 17 OF APPROPRIATION. Subject to such rules and regulations as may be
- 18 implemented by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and after having sought
- 19 the prior approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 20 Committee, the Director of the Department of Workforce Services is hereby
- 21 authorized to make transfers from any appropriation made by this Act to any
- 22 other appropriation made by this Act with the exception of the "Reed Act
- 23 Funds" appropriations set forth in Section 8 of this Act, and of the
- 24 appropriation made for Regular Salaries or Maintenance and General Operation.
- 25 Such transfers may be made whenever it appears, by projecting the

- 2 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
- 3 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
- 4 has determined that the Department of Workforce Services may operate more
- 5 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Workforce
- 6 Services authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both
- 7 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by
- 8 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
- 9 as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative
- 10 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.
- 11 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 12 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,

- 17 SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. INTER-
- 19 AGENCY TRANSFER OF STATE GENERAL REVENUE FOR THE TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR
- 20 NEEDY FAMILIES (TANF) PROGRAMS. Upon the request of the Director of the
- 21 Department of Human Services (DHS) and the Director of the Department of
- 22 Workforce Services (DWS), the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may approve
- 23 up to three million six hundred forty thousand six hundred fifty dollars
- 24 (\$3,640,650) each fiscal year in State General Revenue appropriated to DWS
- 25 for the TANF program to be transferred to the DHS Division of County
- 26 Operations in support of Arkansas' TANF Programs or any related separate
- 27 state programs.
- 28 The Director of the Department of Workforce Services shall provide a
- 29 report of all transfers made to the DHS Division of County Operations to

- 1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
- 2 OF TANF BLOCK GRANT FUNDS. Each fiscal year, the Department of Workforce
- 3 Services shall transfer the sum of seven million five hundred thousand
- 4 dollars (\$7,500,000) from the state's federal Temporary Assistance for Needy
- 5 Families block grant to the Department of Education Public School Fund
- 6 Account to be used solely for the Arkansas Better Chance Program.
- 7 If the state match for the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families grant
- 8 or the state's Temporary Assistance for Needy Families grant is reduced, the
- 9 amount to be transferred may be adjusted in proportion to the percentage
- 10 change in the state match or the state's Temporary Assistance for Needy
- 11 Families grant. The amount to be transferred may also be reduced
- 12 proportionately if new cost requirements are imposed upon the state as a
- 13 result of new or revised Temporary Assistance for Needy Families regulations
- 14 at the federal level.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015
- 16 2016 through June 30, 2016 2017.

- 18 SECTION 24. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRAINING
- 20 TRUST FUND TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, the
- 21 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and
- 22 those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State the sum of two
- 23 million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) from the Department of
- 24 Workforce Services Training Trust Fund to the Skills Development Fund.
- 25 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015
- 26 2016 through June 30, 2016 2017.

- 28 SECTION 25. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
- 29 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
- 30 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
- 31 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 32 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

2	SECTION 26. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
3	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
4	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
5	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
6	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
7	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
8	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
9	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
10	
11	SECTION 27. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
12	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
13	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
14	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of
15	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
16	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
17	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm
18	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
19	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
20	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
21	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.
